STANDING RULES & PROCEDURES

1. Company meetings are usually held at the Tannehill and Tallassee events, but may be called at other times as outlined in the Bylaws.
2. At all re-enactment events and living histories, all members must be dressed in period clothing on Saturday morning no later than 8:00 am, and preferably before leaving their tent/sleeping quarters. Thereafter, period clothing must be worn any time members are outside their sleeping quarters until the event ends. In special circumstances, the Commanding Officer or the 1st Sergeant may waive this requirement.
3. Non-combatants must file a medical form with the Company Secretary within 30 days of joining the Company.
4. Cooking and dish-washing are the responsibility of all male members of the Company. Except in special circumstances, women do not perform these duties during Company events.
5. Maintaining the camp area is everyone's responsibility. Members should police the area upon rising and make every effort to keep unauthentic materials out of sight whenever spectators might be visiting camp. After the camp has been broken down at the end of an event, all members are responsible for cleaning up their respective campsite and helping in the clean-up of common areas.
6. Members that do not attend at least one event during a 2-year period will be moved to an inactive list for a period of 5 years. Members not participating for 5 consecutive years will be named on a separate list for notification of reunions or other special events.
7. It is the responsibility of all members to make sure that both the Commanding Officer and Company Secretary have accurate contact information. Both individuals should be notified as soon as changes are known.
