Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm – 26 in attendance

Secretary's Report, Pam Morse: Motion was made to accept minutes as written in the April Newsletter, 2nd all in favor, passed.

Treasurer's Report, Bob Cossette: Motion was made and 2nd to accept treasurers report as given at meeting, 2nd all in favor, passed.

Vice President's Report, Jack Donaghy: If we are going to St. Agatha to ride in July, I will see what we have to do to join a club so that we can ride there.

Trail Master's Report, Russell Smith: On **June 10th** work detail will be putting up new signs and replacing old ones, cutting brush and clearing the trails. Russell tried to get the Thorsen Road open to ATV Traffic, sad to report that this did not get approved. The Nature Conservancy has use of the land that Trails 501B and 502 – 73000 go through there will be no change to us using the trails.

Personal Membership, Tom Johnston: 88 members and 133 memberships.

Business Membership, Stuart Burr: 19 Members have renewed and Pleasant River Take Out joined as a new business member.

Merchandise Report, Jack Donaghy: If anyone is interested in purchasing any hats (we have new styles in), T-Shirts etc., contact Jack or any club member and we will be glad to catch up with you.

Building Committee: Update - The cement has been poured and the sills are put in place. Pleasant River Lumber has the lumber ready; the 2x4 and 2x6 are in Dover we will have to arrange to have them picked up. A motion was made 2nd to have Doug arrange for the pickup and spend what is needed to get it done, all in favor, passed. Doug will check with Auto Buff (they stated that they would pick them up for us and charge \$300.00) he will also check with Pete Hanson to see if he is available to pick it up for us. (**UPDATE**, lumber is in Hancock, delivered by Pleasant River Lumber).

The electrical wiring has been donated to us. Tom and Doug found a great deal on windows and doors – there are six new windows, three used in great condition and a door all for the price of \$1050.00. A motion was made and 2nd for the purchase, all in favor passed.

Insurance: Bob is looking in to what we need for insurance for the construction of the club house. We cannot start building before we have the insurance.

Fund Raising Committee: The club had a raffle for one cord of wood, cut, split and delivered, or 50 gallons of oil with first ticket drawn getting a choice. 200 tickets were sold at \$5.00 each giving us a total of \$1000.00. Thank you to all that sold tickets. The three highest sellers were Tom Johnston, Jack Donaghy, and Raelene Pert. They each sold 30 tickets.

Gina Bennett, of Sorrento won the cord of wood.
Ed Pappas of New Jersey, won the 50 gallons of oil.

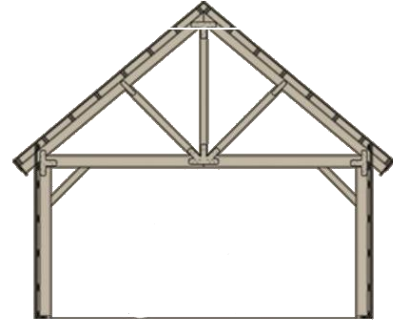

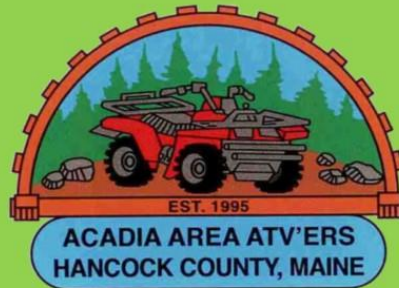

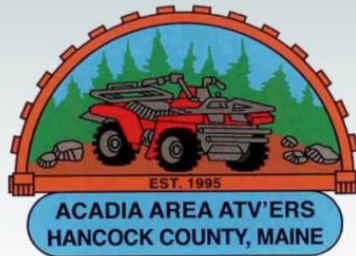
