Work detail dates and locations will be announced at the next club meeting as our Trail Master was busy trying to get another trail for the club.

Merchandise Report, Jack Donaghy: We have lots of merchandise see Jack if interested.

**Building Committee**: Cement slab will be poured on Monday, April 23. Price of lumber has gone up and the 2x4s & 2x6s are in Dover and the rest of lumber will be manufactured in Hancock. Roof trusses, 16 inches on center, EBS \$4990, Viking Lumber \$4489. Motion was made 2<sup>nd</sup> to go with Viking Lumber. A motion was made and 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve electrical, all in favor passed. Material cost to have electricity from pole to building, approximately \$744.00, Shawn Jones, licensed electrician, will hook up the power if we run the wires, at a cost of \$200.00. Wiring will be underground from pole to building. Motion was made 2<sup>nd</sup> all in favor, to set up an account with Viking Lumber, Bob Cossette will look into this.
