Announcements

The **Lancaster Museum and Art Gallery** (LMAG) is currently hosting a special national show of Aviation Art by members of the American Society of Aviation Artists (ASAA). It will be open from June 24 – Aug 20. Museum hours: Tuesday – Saturday 11:00-4:00, Sunday 1:00-4:00, Closed Monday. In addition to the wonderful art exhibition, the museum has created a special and very interesting exhibit of early aviation history in the Antelope Valley. This is a “must see” for local pilots!

On July 27 the LA County Board of Supervisors approved a proposed plan to expand Agua Dulce Air Park. They gave permission to add 18 hangars (to it's present 37), build a 20 room hotel and restaurant, and install 250,000 square feet of outdoor space for tying down airplanes. The vote of 4:1 is subject to final approval in early July. Michael Antonovich voted against the proposal. Instead, he proposed to disapprove the request for the hotel and restaurant and only add 10 new hangars. Stay tuned!
