a) to crave, demand something from someone

her own = himself, herself, itself, themselves

easily provoked = to make sharp, sharpen

a) to stimulate, spur on, urge

- b) to irritate, provoke, arouse to anger
 - 1) to scorn, despise
 - 2) provoke, make angry
 - 3) to exasperate, to burn with anger

thinketh =

- 1) to reckon, count, compute, calculate, count over
 - 1a) to take into account, to make an account of
 - 1a1) metaph. to pass to one's account, to impute
 - 1a2) a thing is reckoned as or to be something, i.e. as availing for or equivalent to something, as having the like force and weight
 - 1b) to number among, reckon with
 - 1c) to reckon or account

evil =

- 1) of a bad nature
 - a) not such as it ought to be
- 2) of a mode of thinking, feeling, acting
 - a) base, wrong, wicked
- 3) troublesome, injurious, pernicious, destructive, baneful

"Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;"

Love does not act unbecomingly craving her own self desires, and is not easily irritated or provoked to anger, and does not consider or meditate on wickedness.

So, when I allow love to flow through me, I do not act in an inappropriate or improper manner, and do not selfishly seek after my own personal desires. I also will not be easily provoked to anger, nor will I consider or entertain sinful and wicked thoughts.
