Notice to Exhibitors

VERY IMPORTANT!! PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!

If you crate your dog in the facility, you **MUST** bring a plastic tarp. The primary crating area is on artificial turf with rubber (Neoprene) matting underneath which **CANNOT** get wet. To be sure you will be able to crate near the running area, **a plastic/waterproof tarp is required** under your crate. If you use a crate mat, you **MUST** still have a tarp underneath it whether the mat is waterproof or not. If you do not have a tarp, there is very limited crating space away from the running area. The Sports Blast is air conditioned, however, if you wish to bring a small fan, it must be battery operated. **NO CLEATS** are allowed in the facility. Please wear flat bottom running shoes/tennis shoes. **NO X-PENS** allowed in the facility. No smoking in the facility.

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Puppies under 6 months old are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Total entry fees less \$7 for each day entered will be refunded for bitches coming into season after the closing date. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund prior to the start of judging trial or by mail, which must be received by June 10, 2009. The request must be accompanied by a veterinarian’s statement.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please help keep the trial site and hotels clean.**
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the trial. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules** on the back. Telegraph, telephone, fax and email entries cannot be accepted.
- Running Orders will be available at the trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

The trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except for bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical performance.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. State health requirements include proof of annual rabies vaccination.

Jump Height Cards

If you have a permanent jump height card or a signed measurement form, please send a photocopy with your entry to avoid check-in at the trials. The person who submits the entry is responsible for entering their dog at the correct jump height. Handlers may not run in a division lower than their proper height division; however, in regular, but not in preferred classes, handlers may opt to run dogs in a higher division. If no height card or measurement form is included, one must be presented at check-in, or dog must be measured before it can run unless it is jumping 24" or 26" and there is no VMO or AKC rep present.

Obstacles

Obstacles meet requirements as described in the current edition of the regulations.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

The facility WILL NOT be available at any time for set up on Thursday

Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing no later than **6:00 PM, Monday, June 8, 2009**. Day to day move-ups during the trial will be allowed providing the request is received by the Trial Secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of judging.

Prizes & Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place teams in each jump height in each class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. New Titling ribbons and MACH and PAX ribbons will be awarded for those finishing a title. Double Q ribbons will be awarded to teams qualifying in both runs on the same day and who are competing in the Excellent B classes. Assorted dog toys and treats valued at no more than \$2 each will be offered as prizes for 1st through 4th placements.

I-65 N or I-65 S: Take I-459 N. Take Exit 19 (Hwy 280). R on Hwy 280 E/Childersburg. **Follow 280 E approx. 7 miles. At the bottom of Double Oak Mtn., L at traffic light onto County Rd 41 N. Take first R onto service road. RVs take 4th R and park in 1st parking lot on R.

I-59 S or I-20 W: Take I-459 S to Exit 19. L on Hwy 280 E. Follow directions above from **.

Hwy 280 W: Go through Chelsea. Continue toward B'ham. At blinking lights, before 2nd traffic light, R into SportsBlast Complex.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
