

# Shamrock Earrings

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## Materials:

Pair of French Earring Wires, or other earring style of choice  
Two beads, size 6/0 mm, in color of choice  
Size 10 Crochet Thread of choice ("Muse" by Zaol used in sample shown)  
Size G-6, 4 mm Crochet Hook  
Tapestry Needle (with eye large enough for thread, but thin enough to pass through beads)

## Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain  
Dc: Double Crochet  
Sc: Single Crochet  
Sl St: Slip Stitch

## Instructions:

Create Two.

Ch 2, Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook. (From this point on, all work is created by working through top 2-loops of sc just created). \*(ch 2, 3 dc, sl st), repeat from \* two more times to create shamrock leaves. Ch 5, sl st in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in each ch, join to work with sl st to create shamrock stem. End off leaving 4" tail.

Thread tail onto Tapestry needle, weave tail up to middle of crochet work (where crochet stitches were created in sc, there should be a hole), thread bead onto needle and secure to work. Finish weaving in tails.

Secure crocheted shamrocks to earring wires.



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
