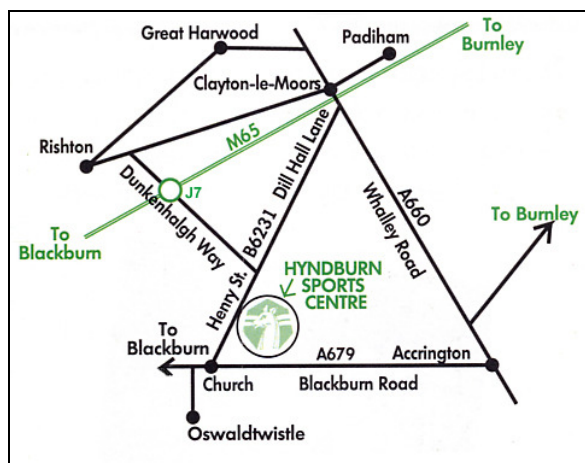

This record status shoot will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Written parental consent must be provided for juniors.
