

Section C – GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

The requirement for General Membership Meetings is stated in the ElderStudy Constitution and Bylaws.

General meetings of the Membership shall be held on the third Wednesday of October and March, or at other times approved by the Board of Directors and announced to the Membership. Meetings are announced in the ElderStudy Newsletter and on the ElderStudy website at least two weeks in advance of the scheduled meeting date. All active members are invited and encouraged to attend.

Beginning with the October 2013 General Membership Meeting, The General Meetings will be held in the Center for Lifelong Learning located at the University's Stafford Campus (SC 20S). However, these meetings may be held at other available venues .

The meetings usually consist of reports by the President, Committee Chairpersons, the Treasurer and a forum for the membership to discuss issues relevant to the ElderStudy operations. In addition, the meeting offers an opportunity for members to get better acquainted with their colleagues. The election of three new members of the Board of Directors occurs at the March meeting. The Membership Committee generally arranges for refreshments at General Membership Meetings
