

Ruffled Cable Purse Pattern



Size 10 ½ needles

Size I crochet hook

Size G crochet hook

Bulky yarn or 2 stands of yarns like I did with Caron Simply

Soft yarn

Ribbon

Closure like snap closure, zipper, etc.

Gauge doesn't matter.

Cast on 38 sts.

Row 1: k2, P2, K4, P6, K4, P2, K4, P6, K4, P2, K2

Row 2-3: knit the knits, purl the purls

Row 4: p2, k2, p4, slip 3 sts knitwise onto cable needle then put needle in the back, knit 3 then knit 3 sts on cable needle, p4, k2, p4, slip 3 sts knitwise onto cable needle then put needle in the front, knit 3 sts then knit 3 sts on cable needle, p4, k2, p2

Row 5-11: knit the knits and purl the purls

Row 12: same as row 4

Row 13-19: knit the knit and purl the purls

Row 20: same as row 4

Row 21-27: knit the knit and purl the purls

Row 28: Same as row 4

Row 29-31: Knit the knits and purl the purls

Repeat from Row 4 to 31 one more time.

Bind off 38 sts.

Sew the sides of rectangle to turn into purse.

Ruffles:

With size I crochet hook:

Row 1: Dc in each back loop of bind off stitches then join 1st dc with slip stitch.

Row 2: Sc in each dc then join 1st sc with slip stitch.

With size G crochet hook:

Row 3: Chain 6 then sc in same sc where slip stitch is, *sc in next dc. Repeat from *. Join with slip stitch in 1st ch of 6 ch loop.

Row 4: Chain 6 then sc in 6 ch loop, *chain 6 then sc in same 6 ch loop, chain 6 then sc in next 6 ch loop. Repeat from *. Join with slip stitch in 1st ch of 1st 6 ch loop.

Row 5: Chain 6 then sc in each 6 ch loop. Join with slip stitch. Fasten off..

“Ridge” under Ruffles (to make ruffles stand up a little bit)

Sc in each front loop of bind off stitches where dcs are in back loops. Join with slip stitch then fasten off..

Weave ribbon in dc stitches area then tie it in the front...

STRAP

It depends on how long you want it to be but make sure it is twice its length to crochet into the strap...

9 strands of yarn together to crochet into chains till it reaches the length you want it to be.. Fasten off..

Attach strap to the side of the purse..

Lining the purse with fabric..

Put any kind of closure you think is appropriate for purse to keep it closed.. I am going to use snap closure to put in when I get new ones....
