
	NO.001 Bulbasaur Seed HT 2'04" WT 15.0 LB	A strange seed was planted on it's back at birth. The plant sprouts and grows with this Pokémon.
	NO.002 Ivysaur Seed HT 3'03" WT 29.0 LB	When the bulb on its back grows large, it appears to lose the ability to stand on it's hind legs.
	NO.003 Venusaur Seed HT 6' 07" WT 221.0 LB	The plant blooms when it is absorbing solar energy. It stays on the move to seek sunlight.
	NO.004 Charmander Lizard HT 2' 00" WT 19.0 LB	Obviously prefers hot places. When it rains, steam is said to spout from the tip of it's tail.
	NO.005 Charmeleon Flame HT 3'07" WT 42.0 LB	When it swings it's burning tail, it elevates the temperature to unbearably high levels.
	NO.006 Charizard Flame HT 5'07" WT 200.0 LB	Spits fire that is hot enough to melt boulders. Known to cause forest fires unintentionally.
	NO.007 Squirtle Tiny Turtle HT 1'08" WT 20.0 LB	After birth, its back swells and hardens into a shell. Powerfully sprays foam from its mouth.
	NO.008 Wartortle Turtle HT 3'03" WT 50.0 LB	Often hides in water to stalk unwary prey. For swimming fast, it moves it's ears to maintain balance.
	NO.009 Blastoise Shell Fish HT 5'03" WT 189.00 LB	A brutal Pokémon with pressurized water jets on it's shell. They are used for high speed tackles.
	NO.010 Caterpie Worm HT 1'00" WT 6.0 LB	It's short feet are tipped with suction pads that enable it to tirelessly climb slopes and walls.
	NO.011 Metapod Cocoon HT 2'04" WT 22.0 LB	This Pokémon is vulnerable to attack while its shell is soft, exposing its weak and tender body.












	NO.012 Butterfree Butterfly HT 3'07" WT 71.0 LB	In battle, it flaps it's wings at high speed to release highly toxic dust in the air.
	NO.013 Weedle Hairy Bug HT 1'00" WT 7.0 LB	Often found in forests, eating leaves. It has a sharp venomous stinger on it's head.
	NO.014 Kakuna Cocoon HT 2'00" WT 22.0 LB	Almost incapable of moving, this Pokémon can only harden it's shell to protect itself from predators.
	NO.015 Beedrill Poison Bee HT 3'03" WT 65.0 LB	Flies at high speed and attacks using it's large venomous stingers on its fore legs and tail.
	NO.016 Pidgey Tiny Bird HT 1'00" WT 4.0 LB	A common sight in forests and woods. It flaps its wings at ground level to kick up blinding sand.
	NO.017 Pidgeotto Bird HT 3'07" WT 66.0 LB	Very protective of its sprawling territorial area, this Pokémon will fiercely peck at any intruder.
	NO.018 Pidgeot Bird HT 4'11" WT 87.0 LB	When hunting, it skims the surface of water at high speed to pick off unwary prey such as Magikarp.
	NO.019 Rattata Rat HT 1'00" WT 8.0 LB	Bites anything when it attacks. Small and very quick, it is a common sight in many places.
	NO.020 Raticate Rat HT 2'04" WT 41.0 LB	It uses it's whiskers to maintain its balance. It apparently slows down if they are cut off.
	NO.021 Spearow Tiny Bird HT 1'00" WT 4.0 LB	Eats bugs in grassy areas. It has to flap its short wings at high speed to stay airborne.
	NO.022 Fearow Beak HT 3'11" WT 84.0 LB	With its huge and magnificent wings, it can keep aloft without ever having to land for rest.












	NO.023 Ekans Snake HT 6'07" WT 15.0 LB	Moves silently and stealthily. Eats the eggs of birds, such as Pidgey and Spearow, whole.
	NO.024 Arbok Cobra HT 11'06" WT 143.0 LB	It is rumored that ferocious warning markings on its belly differ from area to area.
	NO.025 Pikachu Mouse HT 1'04" WT 13.0 LB	When several of these Pokémon gather, their electricity could build and cause a lighting storms.
	NO.026 Raichu Mouse HT 2'07" WT 66.0 LB	Its long tail serves as a ground to protect itself from its own high voltage power.
	NO.027 Sandshrew Mouse HT 2'00" WT 26.0 LB	Burrows deep underground in arid locations far from water. It only emerges to hunt for food.
	NO.028 Sandslash Mouse HT 3'03" WT 65.0 LB	Curls up into a spiny ball when threatened. It can roll while curled up to attack or escape.
	NO.029 Nidoran ♀ Poison Pin HT 1'04" WT 15.0 LB	Although small, its venomous barbs render this Pokémon dangerous. The female has smaller horns
	NO.030 Nidarina Poison Pin HT 2'07" WT 44.0 LB	The female's horn develops slowly. Prefers physical attacks such as clawing and biting.
	NO.031 Nidoqueen Drill HT 4'03" WT 132.0 LB	Its hard scales provide strong protection. It uses its hefty bulk to execute powerful moves.
	NO.032 Nidoran ♂ Poison Pin HT 1'08" WT 20.0 LB	Stiffens its ears to sense danger. The larger its horns, the more powerful its secreted venom.
	NO.033 Nidorino Poison Pin HT 2'11" WT 43.0 LB	An aggressive Pokémon that is quick to attack. The horn on its head secretes a powerful venom.











	NO.034 Nidoking Drill HT 4'07" WT 137.0 LB	It uses its powerful tail in battle to smash, constrict, then break the prey's bones.
	NO.035 Clefairy Fairy HT 2'00" WT 17.0 LB	Its magical and cute appeal has many admirers. It is rare and found only in certain areas.
	NO.036 Clefable Fairy HT 4'03" WT 88.0 LB	A timid fairy Pokémon that is rarely seen. It will run and hide the moment it senses people.
	NO.037 Vulpix Fox HT 2'00" WT 22.0 LB	At the time of birth, it has just one tail. The tail splits from its tip as it grows older.
	NO.038 Ninetails Fox HT 3'07" WT 44.0 LB	Very smart and very vengeful. Grabbing one of its many tails could result in a 1000-year curse.
	NO.039 Jigglypuff Balloon HT 1'08" WT 12.0 LB	When its huge eyes light up, it sings a mysteriously soothing melody that lulls its enemies to sleep.
	NO.040 Wigglypuff Balloon HT 3'03" WT 26.0 LB	The body is soft and rubbery. When angered, it will suck up and inflate itself to an enormous size.
	NO.041 Zubat Bat HT 2'07" WT 17.0 LB	Forms colonies in perpetually dark places. Uses ultrasonic waves to identify and approach targets.
	NO.042 Golbat Bat HT 5'03" WT 121.0 LB	Once it strikes, it will not stop draining energy from the victim even if it gets too heavy to fly.
	NO.043 Oddish Weed HT 1'08" WT 12.0 LB	During the day, it keeps its face buried in the ground, At night, it wanders around sowing its seeds.
	NO.044 Gloom Weed HT 2'07" WT 19.0 LB	The fluid that oozes from it's mouth isn't drool. It is a nectar that is used to attract prey.












	NO.045 Vileplume Flower HT 3'11" WT 41.0 LB	The larger its petals, the more toxic pollen it contains. Its big head is heavy and hard to hold up.
	NO.046 Paras Mushroom HT 1'00" WT 12.0 LB	Burrows to suck tree roots. The mushrooms on the back grow by drawing nutrients from the bug host.
	NO.047 Parasect Mushroom HT 3'03" WT 65.0 LB	A host-parasite pair in which the parasite mushroom has taken over the host bug. Prefers damp places.
	NO.048 Venonat Insect HT 3'03" WT 66.0 LB	Lives in the shadows of tall trees where it eats insects. It is attracted by light at night.
	NO.049 Venomoth Poison Moth HT 4'11" WT 28.0 LB	The dust-like scales covering its wings are color coded to indicate the kinds of poison it has.
	NO.050 Diglett Mole HT 0'08" WT 2.0 LB	Lives about one yard underground where it feeds on plant roots. It sometimes appears above ground.
	NO.051 Dugtrio Mole HT 2'04" WT 73.0 LB	A team of Diglett triplets. It triggers huge earthquakes by burrowing 60 miles underground.
	NO.052 Meowth Scratch Cat HT 1'04" WT 9.0 LB	Adores circular objects. Wanders the streets on a nightly basis to look for dropped loose change.
	NO.053 Persian Classy Cat HT 3'03" WT 71.0 LB	Although its fur has many admirers, it is tough to raise as a pet because of its fickle meanness.
	NO.054 Psyduck Duck HT 2'07" WT 43.0 LB	While lulling its enemies with its vacant look, this wily Pokémon will use psychokinetic powers.
	NO.055 Golduck Duck HT 5'07" WT 469.0 LB	Often seen swimming elegantly by lake shores. It is often mistaken for the Japanese monster, Kappa.












	NO.056 Mankey Pig Monkey HT 1'08" WT 62.0 LB	Extremely quick to anger. It could be docile one moment then thrashing away the next instant.
	NO.057 Primeape Pig Monkey HT 3'03" WT 71.0 LB	Always furious and tenacious to boot. It will not abandon chasing its quarry until it is caught.
	NO.058 Growlithe Puppy HT 2'04" WT 42.0 LB	Very protective of its territory. It will bark and bite to repel its space.
	NO.059 Arcanine Legendary HT 6'03" WT 342.0 LB	A Pokémon that has been admired since the past for its beauty. It runs agilely as if on wings.
	NO.060 Poliwag Tadpole HT 2'00" WT 27.0 LB	Its newly grown legs prevent it from running. It appears to prefer swimming than trying to stand.
	NO.061 Poliwhirl Tadpole HT 3'03" WT 44.0 LB	Capable of living in or out of water. When out of water, it sweats to keep its body slimy.
	NO.062 Poliwrath Tadpole HT 4'03" WT 119.0 LB	An adept swimmer at both the front crawl and breast stroke. Easily overtakes the best human swimmers
	NO.063 Abra PSI HT 2'11" WT 43.0 LB	Using its ability to read minds, it will identify impending danger and Teleport to safety.
	NO.064 Kadabra PSI HT 4'03" WT 125.0 LB	It emits special alpha waves from its body that induce headaches just by being close by.
	NO.065 Alakazam PSI HT 4'11" WT 106.0 LB	Its brain can outperform a supercomputer. Its intelligence quotient is said to be 5,000.












	NO.066 Machop Super Power HT 2'07" WT 43.0 LB	Loves to build its muscles. It trains it all styles of martial arts to become even stronger.
	NO.067 Machoke Super Power HT 4'11" WT 155.0 LB	Its muscular body is so powerful, it must wear a power save belt to be able to regulate its motions.
	NO.068 Machamp Super Power HT 5'03" WT 287.0 LB	Using its heavy muscles, it throws powerful punches that can send the victim clear over the horizon.
	NO.069 Bellsprout Flower HT 2'04" WT 9.0 LB	A carnivorous Pokémon that traps and eats bugs. It uses its root feet to soak up needed moisture.
	NO.070 Weepinbell Fly Catcher HT 3'03" WT 14.0 LB	It spits out Poison Powder to immobilize the enemy and then finishes it with a spray of Acid.
	NO.071 Victreebel Fly Catcher HT 5'07" WT 34.0 LB	Said to live in huge colonies deep in jungles, although no one has ever returned from there.
	NO.072 Tentacool Jellyfish HT 2'11" WT 100.0 LB	Drifts in shallow seas. Anglers who hook them by accident are often punished by its stinging acid.
	NO.073 Tentacruel Jellyfish HT 5'03" WT 121.0 LB	The tentacles are normally kept short. On hunts, they extended to ensnare and immobilize prey.
	NO.074 Geodude Rock HT 1'04" WT 44.0 LB	Found in fields and mountains. Mistaking them for boulders, people often step or trip on them.
	NO.075 Graveler Rock HT 3'03" WT 232.0 LB	Rolls down slopes to move. It rolls over any obstacle without slowing or changing its direction.
	NO.076 Golem Megaton HT 4'07" WT 662.0 LB	Its boulder-like body is extremely hard. It can easily withstand dynamite blasts without damage.












	NO.077 Ponyta Fire Horse HT 3'03" WT 66.0 LB	Its hooves are 10 times harder than diamonds. It can trample anything completely flat in little time.
	NO.078 Rapidash Fire Horse HT 5'07" WT 209.0 LB	Very competitive, this Pokémon will chase anything that moves fast in the hopes of racing it.
	NO.079 Slowpoke Dopey HT 3'11" WT 77.0 LB	Incredibly slow and dopey. It takes 5 seconds for it to feel when under attack.
	NO.080 Slowbro Hermit Crab HT 5'03" WT 173.0 LB	The Shellder that it latched onto Slowpoke's tail is said to feed on the host's left over scraps.
	NO.081 Magnemite Magnet HT 1'00" WT 13.0 LB	Uses anti-gravity to stay suspended. Appears without warnings and uses Thunder Wave and similar moves.
	NO.082 Magneton Magnet HT 3'03" WT 132.0 LB	Formed by several Magnemites linked together. They frequently appear when sunspots flare up.
	NO.083 Farfetch'd Wild Duck HT 2'07" WT 33.0 LB	The sprig of green onions it holds is its weapon. It is used much like a metal sword.
	NO.084 Doduo Twin Bird HT 4'07" WT 86.0 LB	A bird that makes up for its poor flying with its fast foot speed. Leaves giant footprints.
	NO.085 Dodrio Triple Bird HT 5'11" WT 188.0 LB	Uses its three brains to execute complex plans. While two heads sleep, one head stays awake.
	NO.086 Seel Sea Lion HT 3'07" WT 198.0 LB	The protruding horn on its head is very hard. It is used for bashing through thick ice.
	NO.087 Dewgong Sea Lion HT 5'07" WT 265.0 LB	Stores thermal energy in its body. Swims at a steady 8 knots even in intensely cold waters.










	NO.088 Grimer Sludge HT 2'11" WT 66.0 LB	Appears in filthy areas. Thrives by sucking up polluted sludge that is pumped out of factories.
	NO.089 Muk Sludge HT 3'11" WT 66.0 LB	Thickly covered with filthy, vile sludge. It is so toxic, even its footprints contain poison.
	NO.090 Shellder Bivalve HT 1'00" WT 9.0 LB	Its hard shell repels any kind of attack. It is vulnerable only when its shell is open.
	NO.091 Cloyster Bivalve HT 4'11" WT 292.0 LB	When attacked, it launches its horns in quick volleys. Its innards have never been seen.
	NO.092 Gastly Gas HT 4'03" WT 0.2 LB	Almost invisible, this gaseous Pokémon cloaks the target and puts it to sleep without notice.
	NO.093 Haunter Gas HT 5'03" WT 0.2 LB	Because of its ability to slip through block walls, it is said to be from another dimension.
	NO.094 Gengar Shadow HT 4'11" WT 89.0 LB	Under a full moon, this Pokémon likes to mimic the shadows of people and laugh at their fright.
	NO.095 Onix Rock Snake HT 28'10" WT 463.0 LB	As it grows, the stone portions of its body harden to become similar to a diamonds, but colored black.
	NO.096 Drowzee Hypnosis HT 3'03" WT 71.0 LB	Puts enemies to sleep then eats their dreams. Occasionally gets sick eating bad dreams.
	NO.097 Hypno Hypnosis HT 5'03" WT 167.0 LB	When it locks eyes with an enemy, it will use a mix of PSI moves like Hypnosis and Confusion.
	NO.098 Krabby River Crab HT 1'04" WT 14.0 LB	Its pincers are not only powerful weapons, they are used for balance when walking sideways.

	NO.099 Kingler Pincer HT 4'03" WT 132.0 LB	The large pincer has 10000 hp of crushing power. However, its huge size makes it unwieldy to use.
	NO.100 Voltorb Ball HT 1'08" WT 23.0 LB	Usually found in power plants. Easily mistaken for a Poké Ball, they have zapped many people.
	NO.101 Electrode Ball HT 3'11" WT 147.0 LB	It stores electric energy under very high pressure. It often explodes with little or no provocation.
	NO.102 Exeggcute Egg HT 1'04" WT 6.0 LB	Often mistaken for eggs. When disturbed, they quickly gather and attack in swarms.
	NO.103 Exeggutor Coconut HT 6'07" WT 265.0 LB	Legend has it that on rare occasions, one of its heads will drop off and continue as a Exeggcute.
	NO.104 Cubone Lonely HT 1'04" WT 14.0 LB	Because it never removes its skull helmet, no one has seen this Pokémons real face.
	NO.105 Marowak Bone Keeper HT 3'03" WT 99.0 LB	The bone it holds is its key weapon. It throws the bone skillfully like a boomerang to KO targets.
	NO.106 Hitmonlee Kinking HT 4'11" WT 110.0 LB	When in a hurry, its legs lengthen progressively. It runs smoothly with extra long, loping strides.
	NO.107 Hitmonchan Punching HT 4'07" WT 111.0 LB	While apparently doing nothing, it fires punches in lightning fast volleys that are impossible to see.
	NO.108 Lickitung Licking HT 3'11" WT 144.0 LB	Its tongue can be extended like a Charmeleon's. It leaves a tingling sensation when it licks enemies.
	NO.109 Koffing Poison Gas HT 2'00" WT 2.0 LB	Because it stores several kinds of toxic gases in its body. It is prone to exploding without warning.

	NO.110 Weezing Poison Gas HT 3'11" WT 21.0 LB	Where two kinds of poison gases meet, 2 Koffings can fuse into a Weezing over many years.
	NO.111 Rhyhorn Spikes HT 3'03" WT 254.0 LB	Its massive bones are 1000 times harder than human bones. It can easily knock a trailer flying.
	NO.112 Rhydon Drill HT 6'03" WT 265.0 LB	Protected by an armor-like hide, it is capable of living in molting lava of 3,600 degrees.
	NO.113 Chansey Egg HT 3'07" WT 76.0 LB	A rare and elusive Pokémon that is said to bring happiness to those who manage to get it.
	NO.114 Tangela Vine HT 3'03" WT 77.0 LB	The whole body is swathed with wide vines that are similar to seaweed. Its vines shake as it walks.
	NO.115 Kangaskhan Parent HT 7'03" WT 176.0 LB	The infant rarely ventures out of its mother's protective pouch until it is 3 years old.
	NO.116 Horsea Dragon HT 1'04" WT 18.0 LB	Known to shoot down flying bugs with precision blasts of ink from the surface of the water.
	NO.117 Seadra Dragon HT 3'11" WT 55.0 LB	Capable of swimming backwards by rapidly flapping its wing-like pectoral fins and shout tail.
	NO.118 Goldeen Goldfish HT 2'00" WT 33.0 LB	Its tail fin billows like an elegant ballroom dress, giving it the nickname of the Water Queen.
	NO.119 Seaking Goldfish HT 4'03" WT 86.0 LB	In the autumn spawning season, they can be seen swimming powerfully up rivers and creeks.
	NO.120 Staryu Star Shape HT 2'07" WT 76.0 LB	An enigmatic Pokémon that can effortlessly regenerate ant appendage it loses in battle.

	NO.121 Starmie Mysterious HT 3'07" WT 176.0 LB	Its central core glows with the seven colors of the rainbow. Some people value the core as a gem.
	NO.122 Mr. Mime Barrier HT 4'03" WT 120.0 LB	If interrupted while it is miming, it will slap around the offender with its broad hands.
	NO.123 Scyther Mantis HT 4'11" WT 123.0 LB	With ninja-like agility and speed, it can create the illusion that there is more than one.
	NO.124 Jynx Human Shape HT 4'07" WT 90.0 LB	It seductively wiggles its hips as it walks. It can cause people to dance in unison with it.
	NO.125 Electabuzz Electric HT 3'07" WT 66.0 LB	Normally found near power planets, they can wander away and cause blackouts in cities.
	NO.126 Magmar Spit Fire HT 4'03" WT 98.0 LB	Its body always burns with an orange glow that enables it to hide perfectly among flames.
	NO.127 Pinsir Stag Beetle HT 4'11" WT 121.0 LB	If it fails to crush the victim in its pincers, it will swing it around and toss it hard.
	NO.128 Tauros Wild Bull HT 4'07" WT 195.0 LB	When it targets an enemy, it changes furiously while whipping its body with its long tails.
	NO.129 Magikarp Fish HT 2'11" WT 22.0 LB	In the distant past, it was somewhat stronger than the horribly weak descendants that exist today.
	NO.130 Gyarados Atrocious HT 21'07" WT 518.0 LB	Rarely seen in the wild. Huge and vicious, it is capable of destroying entire cities in a rage.
	NO.131 Lapras Transport HT 8'02" WT 485.0 LB	A Pokémon that has been over hunted almost to extinction. It can ferry people across the water.

	NO.132 Ditto Transform HT 1'00" WT 9.0 LB	Capable of copying an enemy's genetic code to instantly transform itself into a duplicate of the enemy.
	NO.133 Eevee Evolution HT 1'00" WT 14.0 LB	Its genetic code is irregular. It may mutate if it is exposed to radiation from element stones.
	NO.134 Vaporeon Bubble Jet HT 3'03" WT 64.0 LB	Lives close to water. Its long tail is ridged with a fin which is often mistaken for a mermaid's.
	NO.135 Jolteon Lightning HT 2'07" WT 54.0 LB	It accumulates negative ions in the atmosphere to blast out 10000 volt lightning bolts.
	NO.136 Flareon Flame HT 2'11" WT 55.0 LB	When storing thermal energy in its body, its temperature could soar to over 1600 degrees.
	NO.137 Porygon Virtual HT 2'07" WT 80.0 LB	A Pokémon that consists entirely of programming code. Capable of moving freely in cyberspace.
	NO.138 Omanyte Spiral HT 1'04" WT 17.0 LB	Although long extinct, in rare cases, it can be genetically resurrected from fossils.
	NO.139 Omastar Spiral HT 3'03" WT 77.0 LB	A prehistoric Pokémon that died out when its heavy shell made it impossible to catch prey.
	NO.140 Kabuto Shellfish HT 1'08" WT 25.0 LB	A Pokémon that was resurrected from a fossil found in what was once the ocean floor eons ago.
	NO.141 Kabutops Shellfish HT 4'03" WT 89.0 LB	Its sleek shape is perfect for swimming. It slashes prey with its claws and drains the body fluids.
	NO.142 Aerodactyl Fossil HT 5'11" WT 130.0 LB	A ferocious, prehistoric Pokémon that goes for the enemy's throat with its serrated saw-like fangs.

	NO.143 Snorlax Sleeping HT 6'11" WT 1014.0 LB	Very lazy. Just eats and sleeps. As its rotund bulk builds, it becomes steadily more slothful.
	NO.144 Articuno Freeze HT 5'07" WT 122.0 LB	A legendary bird Pokémon that is said to appear to doomed people who are lost in icy mountains.
	NO.145 Zapdos Electric HT 5'03" WT 116.0 LB	A legendary bird Pokémon that is said to appear from clouds while dropping enormous lightning bolts.
	NO.146 Moltres Flame HT 6'07" WT 132.0 LB	Known as the legendary bird of fire. Every flap of its wings creates a dazzling flash of flames.
	NO.147 Dratini Dragon HT 5'11" WT 7.0 LB	Long considered a mythical Pokémon until recently when a small colony was found living underwater.
	NO.148 Dragonair Dragon HT 13'01" WT 36.0 LB	A mystical Pokémon that exudes a gentle aura. Has the ability to change climate conditions.
	NO.149 Dragonite Dragon HT 7'03" WT 463.0 LB	An extremely rarely seen marine Pokémon. Its intelligence is said to match that of humans.
	NO.150 Mewtwo Genetic HT 6'07" WT 269.0 LB	It was created by a scientist after years of horrific gene splicing and DNA engineering experiments.
	NO.151 Mew New Specie HT 1'04" WT 9.0 LB	So rare that it is still said to be a mirage by many experts. Only a few people have seen it worldwide.
