Amboseli National Park Safari



Amboseli lies North West of Mt. Kilimanjaro, on the border with Tanzania. It was established as a reserve in 1968 and Gazetted as a National Park in 1974. The park covers 390.26 sq km, and forms part of the much larger 3000sq km Amboseli ecosystem. Large concentrations of wildlife occur here in the dry season, making Amboseli a popular tourist destination. It is surrounded by 6 communally owned group ranches. The National Park embodies 5 main wildlife

habitats (open plains, acacia, woodland, rocky thorn bush land, swamps and marshland) and covers part of a Pleistocene lake basin, now dry.

Within the basin is a temporary lake, Lake Amboseli that flood during years of heavy rainfall. Amboseli is famous for its big game and its great scenic beauty- the landscape is dominated by Mount Kilimanjaro and 'floating' elephants within the swamps.

You will see a fantastic view of Mt. Kilimanjaro, the highest Mountain in Africa rising at 5,896m above sea level. Its snow-capped summit dominates the landscape and on a clear day is easily visible during early morning and late afternoon. A few visitors will go home without superb elephant images beneath Mt. Kilimanjaro.
