

# Bushes that look like bushes



**Right:** Begin the process by stripping a bush sized pinch of Woodland Scenics green Poly Fiber.

**Below:** Roll it between your fingers to create the root ball needed to “plant” it when ready. Grasp the “root ball” with tweezers for the next step.



**Right:** While maintaining your hold with your tweezers, spray a heavy coat of hair spray (Suave Extreme Hold 10 or Aqua Net 10 work very well). To give your bush “branches” a more woody look you can spray the fiber at this point with a light coat of gray primer then follow immediately with the hair spray.





**Left:** While still wet shake on your choice of color and size of ground foam. My preference is Woodland Scenics Blended Turf.

**Below:** Fix your foam in place with a good shot of the hair spray.



**Below:** Production goes very quickly so you can prepare several spots to “plant” your bushes in advance. I use white glue “dots” to hold my bushes in place.



**Below:** Curved end tweezers make “planting” easy. Just place the “root” in the glue and slide the tweezers away as you release their hold.



There you have it, give it a try, improve upon it and tell us how you did it.
