DIRECTIONS

The town of Nova, Ohio is located about an hour southwest of Cleveland. Nova is at the junctions of SR 511 (N-S) and SR 224 (E-W). SR 224 is exit #209 off I-71, and can also be reached via SR 60 and also by off the Ohio Turnpike by taking Gate 7 to SR 250 south to 224 east.

Hado-Bar Farm is located on County Road 1171 which is approximately 2 miles west of SR 511 and about the same distance east of SR 60. Turn south off SR 224 and it will be the first farm about ¾ mile on your right. From the motels, take SR 250 out of town to either SR 511 or SR 60 to SR 224.

COFFEE AND DONUTS WILL BE AVAILABLE EACH MORNING

A light lunch will be available each day.

ALTERNATES: The following information is how EVRC will handle alternates these three days of Tests and Trials, both sheep and ducks. EVRC will accept a maximum of 8 (eight) alternates test and trial combined. There are 3 Events this three day weekend. In the event limits are reached prior to closing, alternates will be numbered 1 - 8 as they come in. Once entries close, the alternates will be numbered by class. Example: Alternates #2 and #5 are both in the advanced sheep class. They are then renumbered A1 and A2. The trials will start with Advanced sheep and end with Herding Tested ducks each day. At the time of closing, there will be a set number of Test and Trial runs. This will not change. If there ends up being a Trial run available with no Trial alternates, the run CANNOT be changed to a Test run. Each alternate will be notified by email that they are on the alternate list and given the opportunity to pull or remain on the list. You need to make sure your email address is readable. Or phone number if you do not have email. A refund will be given, less a \$5.00 fee, if the Secretary is notified prior to

the trial start and an alternate takes that run. No alternate, no refund. If you are an alternate and pull prior to closing or don't have an opportunity to run your check will be returned.

If you are an alternate, and have the opportunity to run and aren't present to run your dog, no refund will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON will run in catalog order in all trial classes, but will be placed at the end of the running order in all test classes.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whoever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print clearly and carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

DECLINATION OF ENTRIES: Emerald Valley Rottweiler Club of Greater Cleveland, Inc. (EVRC) may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against EVRC or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event a dog is not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test/Trial.

REFUNDS: If you pull your entry(ies) prior to closing your check will either be returned or a FULL refund made.

If your dog is pulled after entries close and an alternate fills your place, a full refund will be made.

If your dog is pulled after entries close without an alternate taking your place, no refund will be made.
