SEASON ONE (1982-83)

GHOST OF CELL BLOCK G

September 24, 1982

Hooch and Daddy-O must investigate why every lone occupant of City Cell Block G dies a violent and mysterious death.

SCHOOLBOY CRUSH

October 1, 1982

Daddy-O falls for a young teacher, Darcy Rose, while he investigates the kidnapping of a grade school student.

BROTHEL BLUES

October 8, 1982

Darcy turns to a life of prostitution as a way to cope with the loss of her student.

SUCKER PUNCH (PART ONE)

October 15, 1982

Daddy-O poses as an up-and-coming boxer and Hooch as his trainer, as the pair of detectives attempt to uncover details regarding the mysterious death of a local prizefighter.

SUCKER PUNCH (PART TWO)

October 22, 1982

Hooch arrests boxing promoter Benny Frotelli and Daddy-O miraculously awakens from a boxing induced coma.

FRESH OFF THE BOAT

November 5, 1982

Hooch helps Mrs. Delvecchio's nephew Ace - an illegal alien - get out of trouble and get his green card.

THE LOST PRECINCT

November 12, 1982

In a part of the city long forgotten, Hooch and Daddy-O are called into investigate a murder case that was considered closed - until a mysterious note is received that clears the name of the cop who had been implicated in the crime.

FORCED VENGEANCE

November 19, 1982

Hooch is blackmailed into avenging the death of a man who he put on Death Row.

RINSE AND SPIT

November 26, 1982

Recent immigrant Ace Delvecchio is unwittingly caught up in a blackmail scheme, as he's drugged by a sadistic dentist. Hooch comes to his rescue, inspiring Ace to join the force.

JUSTICE ON WHEELS

December 3, 1982

Hooch and Daddy-O strap on roller skates to catch a few small time crooks, only to be setup for a showdown with a pack of ninjas.

DARCY IN THE SKY WITH DIAMONDS (A VERY SPECIAL EPISODE)

December 10, 1982

January 7, 1983

May 6, 1983

SEASON TWO (1983-84)

KARATE CHOP SHOP

September 23, 1983

Hooch and Daddy-O infiltrate the headquarters of a stolen car ring and use their martial artistry to defeat the ringleader and his henchmen.

IGOR THE SNITCH

September 30, 1983

Hooch and Daddy-O with the help of an informant smash a Russian gun trafficking syndicate and rescue officers Tate and Wilton from certain doom.

DARCY GOES HOME

October 7, 1983

Darcy receives a letter from her sick mother to come home - and quickly realizes a hooker can never truly go home.

PICKPOCKET PURSUIT

October 14, 1983

October 21, 1983

November 11, 1983

December 9, 1983

Hooch and Daddy-O bust Mr. Cross's crew who have been intercepting turkeys that were intended for orphanages throughout the city.

CONFESSION TO MURDER

January 4, 1984

When a hitman confesses to his parish priest, it's up to Hooch & Daddy-O to get the goods on the killer, while keeping Father Mirelli out of the hands of the local mob.

DADDY-O'S BIG DAY

January 13, 1984

When Daddy-O finally tracks down his biological father, he opens the door to a painful past - and an offer that could make him hang up his badge forever.

WHEN COPS DREAM, DO THEY DREAM IN BLACK AND BLUE?

January 20, 1984

When Cross puts a hallucinogenic drug in the air vents, the precinct falls into a deep sleep - and have to face their inner demons in their dreams.

THE PRINCESS AND THE PIGS

January 27, 1984

When Tate and Wilton are assigned by Captain Grayson to work security detail for a visiting Princess, they find themselves at odds with each other - when they both fall in love with her.

SOUTHERN HOSPITALITY

February 10, 1984

Hooch and Daddy-O hit the road for Hazzard County, when vacationing officers Tate and Wilton are thrown in jail by a corrupt Southern sheriff. Special appearances by John Schneider and Tom Wopat.

TRICKLE DOWN THEORY

February 17, 1984

Budget cuts threaten to close the precinct - or is the real threat the corrupt new mayor? Captain Grayson is caught between duty to his officers and duty to the city.

DISHONORABLE DISCHARGE

February 24, 1984

Hooch's old Army buddy, Jack McGee, returns to town and stirs up some old demons. When Jack is rumored to be working for Mr. Cross, Hooch is forced to cut his ties the hard way.

KINGS OF THE NIGHT TIME WORLD

March 9, 1984

Hooch, Daddy-O, and Ace take a night off to take their ladies dancing and paint the town red - but they soon find out that sometimes; red is the color of blood.

AN EYE FOR AN EYE IN THE BIG BLUE SKY

March 23, 1984

Captain Grayson asks Hooch and Daddy-O to accompany a convicted serial killer being transported by plane to the state prison - and little do they know, this could be a one way trip.

DEAD TRAMP WALKING

April 20, 1984

When Darcy is set up by a vindictive judge, it's up to Hooch and Daddy-O to prove her innocent and keep her off death row.

September 28, 1984

Captain Grayson begins to exhibit strange behavior and is told to take a leave of absence - that takes him the edges of insanity.

WHEN THE MOON HITS YOUR EYE LIKE A BIG HOOCHIE PIE

October 5, 1984

Hooch falls for the daughter of a mob boss, and it's up to Daddy-O to save him.

ACE IN DISGRACE

October 12, 1984

Rookie cop Ace Delvecchio is framed for importing non-prescription drugs.

DOUBLE CROSSED

October 19, 1984

Captain Grayson's world is turned upside down as Mr. Cross is revealed to be his estranged brother.

NOT WITHOUT MY PARTNER

October 26, 1984

Hooch is kicked off the force for allegedly disposing of evidence in order to protect his troubled nephew and Daddy-O defends his honor.

SPRING FEVER

November 2, 1984

It's a bad day in the precinct, as temperatures heat up and one crisis follows another: a teen jumps into the bear pit at the zoo, a turf battle between two pimps escalates into a near-riot, and Tate and Wilton aren't speaking after a misunderstanding.

November 9, 1984

When Darcy's sister Cindy comes to town, Daddy-O falls hard - but should he?

SUNDOWN FOR SQUEEGEE

November 16, 1984

Squeegee is missing, and an ancient druidic cult is about to make him their next human sacrifice. It's up to Hooch and Daddy-O to find him before the upcoming winter solstice.

STREETS ON FIRE

November 23, 1984

Teenaged gang members are out of control, and threatening the entire city. Can some tough love turn these youths around and get them back on the right path? Scott Baio guest stars

GO ASK ACE

November 30, 1984

Ace's new girlfriend is perfect - until she gets him hooked on smack. Can Hooch & Daddy-O get him off the junk before he's booted off the force?

TALE OF THE IMMIGRANT BUTCHER

December 7, 1984

Hooch and Daddy-O are quietly summoned to the 17th Street Meat Market by their old friend, organist Chaim Witz - who is wearing a bomb-rigged collar that will detonate if Hooch and Daddy-O don't free a man they recently put on a Death Row.

WHEN A DEAD COP IS NOT

December 14, 1984

On the day of a memorial service for two slain officers, Hooch and Daddy-O return to the murder scene to pay respects. Only to find a clue that leads them to find that one of the officers is still alive!

THE CHAMPIONS OF JUSTICE

January 4, 1985

A gang of vigilantes who call themselves "The Champions of Justice" come into town with seemingly good intentions - until the body count rises too high for Hooch and Daddy-O to ignore.

PASSPORT TO KILL COUNTRY

January 11, 1985

The boys head up to Canada to help local police investigate a new hunting game for high rollers where the guns are real - and the prey are women. Guest starring Geddy Lee of Rush.

NOT FOR THE INNOCENT

January 18, 1985

With great pride, Hooch and Daddy-O share an Law Enforcement Officers of the Year Award for the capture of pyromaniac Ken Browstow - but a tip received later that night tells them that they might have put the wrong man behind bars.

SOMEWHERE BETWEEN THE JUNK AND THE FUNK

February 1, 1985

When FunkFest '85 rolls into town, Hooch and Daddy-O must trail a Jamaican drug runner who is posing as a bass player for the band "Chunky LUV".

THE MARIACHI MURDERS

February 15, 1985

A mysterious mariachi has been serenading women who wind up dead. Hooch and Daddy-O must catch the killer as he makes a run for the border.

BLACK LIKE ME

March 8, 1985

Tensions are building in the city, after a series of arsons and riots. Hooch is forced to go deep under cover with the Black Panthers to find the radical ringleaders and shut them down.

GREASEPAINT AND GUNSMOKE

March 15, 1985

After a number of young actresses go missing, Hooch and Daddy-O investigate a touring theatre company. The flamboyant actor-manager knows more than he's saying, and it's up to H&D to bring down the curtain on a Sultan's plan to expand his harem.

May 3, 1985

SEASON FOUR (1985-86)

TEARS OF A CLOWN (PART ONE)

September 27, 1985

Hooch and Daddy-O discover that a traveling circus is merely a front for a multi-million dollar cocaine ring.

TEARS OF A CLOWN (PART TWO)

October 4, 1985

Daddy-O battles a group of clowns and fights off a ferocious lion in order to rescue a helpless Hooch who suffers from coulrophobia.

PEDAL TO THE METAL

October 11, 1985

Hooch and Daddy-O go undercover as truckers rescue Darcy and bust up a cross-country white slavery ring.

MAKE LOVE TO THE CAMERA (PART ONE)

October 18, 1985

Hooch is missing and Daddy-O has to go undercover as a high fashion photographer to rescue his partner and defend national security.

MAKE LOVE TO THE CAMERA (PART TWO)

October 25, 1985

With his partner still missing, Daddy-O gets desperate and takes a beautiful fashion designer into his confidence. Hearts are broken when he discovers she's the head of an international smuggling ring.

FIVE CARD DRAW

November 5, 1985

Daddy-O's Las Vegas vacation is interrupted, when he stumbles on a crooked gambling scheme. Ted McGinley stars as "3-Card" Monty DeLario.

COPS ON A HOT TIN ROOF

November 15, 1985

Hooch and Daddy-O go deep undercover into the seedy underbelly of the city to bust gay drug lord Miguel Fazio.

FINAL ROLL CALL

November 22, 1985

Mr. Cross takes Darcy hostage and Captain Grayson must fight him to the death in order to save her.

DADDY-O'S DELIGHT

November 29, 1985

Hooch and Daddy-O go undercover in the new underground rap scene to catch the man who's been killing rappers. Features the rap song "You're Busted!" performed by the cast.

THE GOLDEN SQUEEGEE (A VERY SPECIAL EPISODE)

December 6, 1985

Squeegee comes in contact with a street urchin - who has a secret that will change Squeegee's life forever.

DREIDEL, DREIDEL, DREIDEL (HOLIDAY SPECIAL)

December 13, 1985

A tragic misunderstanding puts two local religious communities - and Hooch and Daddy-O - at odds. Daddy-O must come to terms with his lapsed faith and Hooch learns a lesson about tolerance.

TWO FACED ACE

January 3, 1986

A concussion suffered on the job turns Ace into a raging madman.

WEDDING BELL BLUES (A.K.A. HOOKER TO A HOUSEWIFE)

January 10, 1986

When Ace's green card expires, he has to marry Darcy to stay in this country. This marriage of convenience gets complicated when Darcy falls in love with Ace, but Ace is in love with his work.

THE BASEMENT BREAKERS

January 17, 1986

Why is it that the members of the breakdancing troupe "Basement Breakers" are dropping like flies? Hooch and Daddy-O must find out - and bust a move!

ANATOMY OF A 5150

January 24, 1986

A "Real-Time" episode that tracks 50 minutes of a Hooch and Daddy-O case from start to finish as they take down a manic depressive graffiti artist who threatens to blow up one of the city's DMVs.

COTTONHEAD CASUALTY

January 31, 1986

Hooch struggles with flashbacks about shooting an elderly woman as a rookie. Daddy-O questions his partner's commitment to the force during an emotional meltdown. Estelle Getty guest stars.

BLOOD BROTHERS

February 7, 1986

A mobster who killed Daddy-O's brother is released from prison. Hooch must fight to stop his partner from succumbing to police brutality and becoming the target of the Mafia.

BETTER OFF DEAD

February 21, 1986

A murdered beauty queen's body is missing from the city morgue. Hooch and Daddy-O are forced to go undercover into the underground necrophilia market to unravel the mystery.

SET-UP JOB

February 28, 1986

A Cuban drug lord frames Squeegee for murder and Hooch defends him in court against a hotshot district attorney.

GRAND THEFT RETARD

March 14, 1986

Mentally ill children begin disappearing for weeks at a time - then mysteriously reappear in the Mojave Desert. Hooch and Daddy-O are summoned by the government to investigate.

THE SERIAL SCRIBBLER

April 18, 1986

Hooch and Daddy-O chase down a psychotic who is murdering hookers and leaving illegible notes behind at the murder scenes.

THE DADDY-O DIARIES

May 9, 1986

Daddy-O is shot during a drug bust and the rest of the force reminisces about him while he recovers in the hospital.

SEASON FIVE (1986)

THE PRIEST WITH THE MAGIC TOUCH

September 26, 1986

Hooch and Daddy-O must go undercover as choir members to investigate what questionable activities are taking place at "The Church of the Falling Sky".

CALLING DR. CRUSH

October 3, 1986

Hooch and Daddy-O investigate a surgeon who has been performing a lot of unnecessary surgeries - that end in death!

HOOCH AND DADDY-O MEET JACK THE RIPPER

October 9, 1986

Hooch and Daddy-O travel to 19th century London to unravel a series of mysterious murders involving prostitutes.

TAKE ME OUT TO THE D.E.A.T.H. GAME!

October 16, 1986

Hooch and Daddy-O assist the FBI in confronting a terrorist group called the Degenerate Eastern Armenian Truth Hellions.

GOOD TOUCH, BAD TOUCH

October 22, 1986

Tate and Wilton have to make some tough decisions after a co-worker on the force begins to sexually harass them.

DOIN' TIME FOR A RHYME CRIME

November 5, 1986

A beat poet tired of rejection and poorly attended performances decides to stage one last performance called the "Suicide Mudslide" - can Hooch and Daddy-O stop him in time?
