**Directions:** From Burford, take A361 towards Chipping Norton and just after Shipton-under-Wychwood at the top of a long hill, turn left signed to Lyneham. Go through Lyneham and you will see a golf course on your left. The entrance to Lyneham Heath Farm is opposite the Golf Course (gravel drive not tarmac). Follow gravel drive to top and bear left past the stables. Horsebox parking is straight ahead. ## **ROYAL WINDSOR SHOW AREA QUALIFIER (CLASS 3a & 3b):**

This class is only open to current BRC members.

The British Riding Club's Royal Windsor Area Entry Form : the horse's name shown on the entry form must be that on the flu vaccination certificate.

The highest placed combination (both Senior and Junior Sections) will qualify for the BRC Grass Roots Championships at the Royal Windsor Horse Show in May 2012. One rider per class will qualify – two will qualify if there are 13 or more starters in the class. Riders who qualify at the Area Qualifier will be given a Qualification Card which will be signed by the Area Steward officiating at the Area Qualifier. This Qualification Card must accompany the entry for the championships at RWHS.

This class will be run under BRC General Rules and specific rules for dressage.

Equine Influenza – Horses and Ponies must comply fully with BRC Rule G7 which refers to vaccinations against equine influenza (please see BRC website). The Official Steward will inspect all horse passports in that class before the horse/pony is allowed to compete. Any horse/pony failing these requirements in rule G7 will not be permitted to compete.

Riders must present their hat for checking and tagging to the BRC Official Steward in accordance with BRC rules 2012, regardless of whether a BE or PC tag is also shown.

## **GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

No responsibility is accepted by the landowners and the organisers for any injury, negligence, accident, damage or illness to any person, animal, vehicles or property whatsoever. Any person entering the showground does so at their own risk.

The unaffiliated show is open to all members of the Pony Club, Affiliated Riding Clubs, BHS, BE, BSJA, BD and non-affiliated members with their own insurance (except Class 3 – see above).

Hard hats and boots with heels must be worn at all times by anyone mounted on the showground. Failure to do so will incur elimination from the show. Headgear must conform to current BRC safety standards and must be marked either PAS 015, BSEN1384, EN1384, ASTM F1163, SNELL E2001 or prefixed with SEI. Recommended hard hats must carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark or SEI. Hats must have a 3 point fastening or harness and be correctly adjusted and fastened. If you choose to wear a hat that does not conform to these standards, you do so at your own risk; you will not be covered by our British Riding Club insurance and the show organisers will not accept any liability in the event of an accident however caused. For Class 3 – please see above.

The judges' and/or organisers' decision is final.

All classes are unaffiliated but will be run in accordance with British Riding Club / British Dressage rules where applicable.

The organisers may refuse entry without giving a reason.

The judges reserve the right to eliminate any unsound or unfit horse/pony.

All horse/ponies must be over 4 years old.

Any horse/pony which, in the opinion of the organisers or veterinary surgeon, is liable to prove in any way infectious to other animals is liable to immediate exclusion from the showground without any refund of entry.

No entry fee will be refunded without a doctor's/veterinary certificate.

Any person seen ill-treating a horse/pony will be asked to leave.

Children must be properly supervised at all times.
