MEMBERS RELEASES: Whenever you send out a release, email me and I'll post it up here for you, as well.

SPOTLIGHT MEMBER: This area is always a surprise. None of the members knows who I may be spotlighting at any given time.

MEMBERS BOOKSTORE: If you have a published book, send me a jpeg of the cover and a short write-up and I'll place it in our bookstore. Provide a link where you would like the readers to go and buy it.

SEEKING INTERVIEWEES: If you are conducting research for a future novel and are searching for readers to help you out, send me what you are looking for and I'll post it up for you. All readers responding will be given your email address.

January 9th 2006---proposals to be sent in

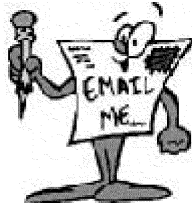
March 1st 2006---first draft to be sent to me
