- *School Assistant (Mathematics) (Physical Science) (Biological Science) (Social Studies) (English) shall take the concerned subjects for classes VIII to X.
 - *School Assistant (Physical Science) has to take Mathematics for Classes VI and VII.
 - *Every School Assistant /SGT has to take any of the following subjects.
 - *Mathematics / Science / Social Studies / English of VI and VII Classes
 - *Moral Education, work experience and Games
 - *Sports, Debates, Elocution, Essay Writing, Quiz programme etc of VI and VII Classes.

As allotted by the Head of the Institution. They shall not refuse to take the above subjects.

PET shall attend the school in the morning session from 8 a.m./9 a.m. to 11 a.m./12 a.m. and in the after noon session from 2 p.m./3 p.m. to 4 p.m./ 5.30 p.m. He shall assist the Head Master to conduct Assembly, maintain discipline and conduct Games & Sports after School hours and assists the Head Master in all School Functions.

III. NUMBER OF PERIODS TO BE GIVEN TO THE TEACHERS.

No teacher shall be given more than 30 periods per week except in exceptional circumstances. Every teacher shall take a minimum of 24 periods per week.

Teacher shall be in the school by 8.45 A.M./9.45 A.M. and shall attend to the School Assembly. If any teacher fails to attend the School Assembly on any day he/she has to apply for half a day CL or eligible leave for that day.

The School may adopt their own Timings for the school with the approval of school Education Committee, which should be submitted in advance to the District Educational Officer through concerned Deputy Educational Officer. The instructional hours per day shall not less than 5 Hrs 30 minutes and the minimum number of working days shall be 220 days during the academic year.

IV. DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

Disciplinary action will be initiated against the Head Master/Teachers concerned of all managements if he/she deviates from any of the above guidelines. Action will be taken to withdraw permission to the Schools under private managements if any Management fails to implement the above guidelines.
