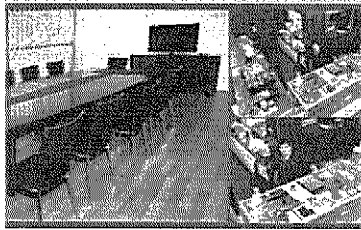

WHILE living in China, local artist Danny Huynh created a body of work called *A Sense of Place*.

He was inspired by the architecture and landscape of Shanghai. The exhibition is on show at Casula Powerhouse until Sunday, October 11.

It examines the relationship between the old and new Shanghai.

### Gig revives Azra beat

THE spirit of Balkan band Azra will rock on stage for the first time in Australia on Saturday, August 15, at the Sunnybrook Hotel, Warwick Farm.

*A Tribute to Azra Live* will see local bands playing songs made famous by the rock and roll band in the former Yugoslavia in the late 1970s and early 1980s.

The first album from Azra was released in 1980.

They stopped recording in 1988. Front man Johnny Stulic released a further two albums and retired to Holland. However, Azra remains popular with both young and old audiences from former Yugoslavia.

Local bands Slumdogs and Maraton will play the best of Azra hits.

They will be joined by solo musicians on acoustic guitar and piano. After the live performance, DJ Miki will play a wide range of Azra songs.
