O (5) 1 Hayes' Germanus Guardian (AI) JW. Upstanding masculine headed m who made the best use of his construction on the move in this class. Balanced all through, standing on tight feet. Good length of ribcage leading to strong well muscled quarters. True coming and going, in good coat and well handled, BoB & G4. 2 Russell & Andrew's Kimmax Bourbon, close up to the winner and I did prefer his head, however he didn't make such good use of himself on the move today. 3 Love's Karlejay Gump Kruger.

Italian Spinone

O (2) Difficult class to split, two top quality males. 1 Carruthers' Bannonbrig Al Fresco ShCM, striking type of a dog presenting a wholly typical outline. Correctly proportioned headpiece with good eye and ear set. Reachy neck to best of shoulders with a useful return of upper arm. Well developed in forechest and ribbing. Strong over the loin leading on to well muscled and angled quarters. Strode out freely and accurately on the move to clinch BoB & Group 1. 2 Lawton's Hastabbie Louis Dousset for Oaklaw, very close up to the winner and in a hair splitting decision I just preferred the head of 1. Sound and honest, I also liked this dog a lot.

Pointer

O (2) 1 Rossier, Fox & Mosedale's Am Ch Marsuz Alydar I Like It I Love It at Schiuiia. Handler is now getting to grips with the dog and he presents a very balanced and typical outline with excellent angulation fore and aft. Masculine head, the best of necks and a wonderful forehand with desired depth to forechest. Well ribbed back, strong topline and loin and very well muscled quarters. Strode out covering ample ground with a free and easy action. Feet need attention. 2 Lavery & McNab's Gideon The Profiler, close up to the winner however was knuckling over in front and spoiling outline today.

Spaniel (Cocker)

J (7) 1 Lots of enthusiastic youngsters in this class, it was lovely to see them all enjoying their time in the ring. 1 Bodzack's Whinburn Win Me Over. Ended up moving up the class on the go around based on her scopey side gait and accurate foot fall. Soundly constructed all through, balanced fore and aft, presented in good coat and condition. Did prefer the head of 2 at the moment. 2 Murray's Strathturret Boogie Woogie. Another smart young lady with a beautiful head and expression, just not so together on the move just now, but I am sure she will mature on nicely. 3 Murray's Strathturret Wildest Dream.

G (7) 1 Murray's Strathturret Moonwalker. Masculine headed, correct eye and expression. Strong neck, and good front angulation. Well ribbed up, compact in his shape throughout with well angulated rear. Moved out best in this class and presented in excellent coat. Handler just needs to get to grips with his enthusiasm. 2 Hynd's Scomar Interceptor, strong headed male, well made and true enough in movement. 3 Neatham & Gribbin's Lynwater Sea Dream.

O (10,2) 1 Adams' Whinburn Whispering Dreams ShCM. Absolutely feminine from head to tail. Sweet head and expression, correctly set on ears. Reachy neck to best of shoulders and a useful return of upper arm. Deep enough through the brisket, ribcage extending well back to short loin.

Strong over the group, well angled stifle and low hocks. Coat in good nick. Strode out with characteristic merry action covering plenty of ground. BoB & G2.

Irish Setter

O (3) Difficult class to judge 1 Barnes' Fetteresk Double Charm. This young lady made the best use of her construction on the move today. Sound coming and going, just needs to grow some more coat now to compliment the picture. 2 Deighton's Balintyne Once In A While, not moving at his best with an erratic rear action. 3 Paterson's Heathclare Muirs Magic.

Retriever (Flat Coated)

O 1 Reid's Orkhatos Phoebe ShCM. Headed a nice class, typy bitch who won today having the edge on movement and front construction. Sweet head and kind eye, strong neck. Balanced fore and aft and presented in very fit condition which was a pleasure to see. Moved out true. BoB.

Hungarian Vizsla

O (1) 1 McCall's Kazval Helvelin. Alone but worthy winner, superb for type throughout. Presents a balanced typical outline, excellent head of correct proportions. Strong reach neck to super front, well developed in forechest and ribbing. Short and strong through loin, leading on to well angled quarters. Stood on good feet and presented in good coat and super muscle. Moved out true with good front reach and powerful drive. BoB & G3.

Retriever (Labrador)

G (1) 1 Jennings Seatallan Snowdrop at Kiltyrie. Nicely proportioned black standing on a good front. Well ribbed and presented in fit condition. Very erratic in front action today.

O (4,2) Difficult class to assess as I preferred the type of 2 however 1 was presented in a far more fit for function condition. 1 Jennings' Seatallan Shamrock at Kiltyrie ShCM. Smart yellow d who really looked fit for his job which was a delight to see. Nicely proportioned head with keen expression. Balanced fore and after and well ribbed in the middle. In good coat. Moved out well enough, good side gait. Feet need attention. BoB. 2 Morgan's Malcvale Scarlet Ribbons at Tessholly. I liked the type of this bitch however she was far too fat and out of condition.

Retriever (Golden)

P (4,1) 1 Dunbar's Linirgor Braidwynn Je T'aime. I thought this young lady was quite outstanding, very typy and brimming with confidence and joy. Sweet head of correct proportions, dark mischevious eyes. Reachy neck leading into a well laid shoulder and useful return of upper arm. Excellent depth of forechest. Well ribbed back, level topline, short and strong through the loin. Excellent angulation through hindquarters. Tail set correct and carried as such on the move. Going away and coming on she has accurate footfall and in profile excellent reach and drive whilst retaining a strong topline. Presented in superb coat and condition, handled well. Her type and accuracy of movement clinched her BoB. 2 Williamson & Thomas' Ronjalee Roxy Lady. Nice type, shade longer cast than the winner and just not firmed up in hind action as yet. 3 Liberska & Kerl's Goldeness Summer Love.

J (1) 1 Dunbar's Linirgor O O Seven. Upstanding masculine headed d presenting a typical outline stacked up. Liked his expression and kind eye. Balanced in construction fore and aft which he used

to advantage on the move. Well ribbed up and presented in good coat and condition. Considered for BoB. Well handled and presented.

N (3,2) 1 Welsh's Knockothie Drummer Boy. Particularly impressed with the d's excellent muscular condition, however he was a little flat on his feet which was surprising. Balanced in construction and well handled.

G (5) 1 Cochrane's Denmarella Destiny of Ronhills. Ultra feminine b, who has such a kindly disposition. Really sweet head and expression. Reachy neck to good forehand assembly and straight limbs. Well ribbed back. Balanced in hind angulation, she used her construction to good effect on the move. Just a tad lacklustre in the challenge for BoB, but a worthy contender of good type. 2 Brady's Dunnybrae Heavny Among Larena. Different type and head to the winner but close up as well constructed, just a little erratic on the move because of her enthusiasm. 3 Purdie's Dunnybrae Honolulu.

O (4) 1 Barron & Jenkins Rannaleroch Beinn Bhreac JW. Long cast d. Balanced enough in front and rear angulation. Pleasant head, in good muscular condition. Good side gait. 2 Welsh's Linirgor Luv Em an Leave Em, better head than the winner however not quite so tidy going away and coming towards. Good feet. 3 Brady's Larena Isle of Dreams.
