



Make you own Iftar dining cloth

Buy a plastic or vinyl table cloth (get one at the Dollar Store)

Write down tablecloth measurements.

Find washable decorative fabric on sale that you like and get the proper yardage equal to tablecloth purchased. (We recommend buying one not bigger than 60" wide, most fabric is not wider than that, though you will come across some decorator fabric that is 72" wide, but it may not be washable]

1. Cut the yardage of decorative fabric in half and reposition them to form a square (Use the purchased tablecloth for a pattern and cut around it with the fashion fabric. If necessary, sew 2 pieces of decorator fabric together to obtain correct size.). Sew the two pieces together. Repeat this step for the tablecloth. You should now have two large squares.
2. Sew the two large squares right sides together like you would a giant pillowcase (Leave an opening to turn right side out). Press seams open (on something like this, you don't really need to press seams open and it may melt the vinyl), trim corners and trim any excess fabric on the sides.

3. Turn fabric right side out and sew up opening (you may want to topstitch all the way around and maybe some on the inside to minimize shifting or sliding).

How about making two, and giving one as a gift?
