AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of the sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- **Sportsman respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.**
- **Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.**
- **Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.**
- **The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.**
- **The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.**
- **The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something else.**
- **The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.'The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.**
- **Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of the competitors.**
- **Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.**
- **Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.**
- **Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of his breeding stock.**
- **Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.**
- **Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.**
- **Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.**

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" and. If this entry is for an obedience trial the "Obedience Regulations", have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trail and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, it's members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendent or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless of any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property , arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid black, ASCOB particolor). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. Over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed, The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division. color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of it's new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTER-NATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Post Dated Checks & Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There will be **no refunds** for duplicate entries. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, fax or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

THE WINNER OF A THIRD FIRST PLACE IN EACH NOVICE CLASS SHALL AUTOMATICALLY BECOME ELIGIBLE TO ENTER IN THE CORRESPONDING OPEN CLASS AT THE SHOW, PROVIDED THE WIN IS THE THIRD FIRST PLACE AWARD WITH COMPETITION AND FURTHER PROVIDED THERE ARE ONE OR MORE JUNIOR HANDLERS COMPETING IN THAT OPEN CLASS.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the breed or obedience classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season, or a veterinarian's excuse, may be replaced by another dog meeting the below ownership requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such requests must be made one half hour prior to the judging of any regular classes at the show. Each dog must be owned, co-owned by the Junior Handler or Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. At a Specialty show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a breed judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

ENTRIES FOR REGULAR JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES SHALL CLOSE AT THE SAME TIME THAT ENTRIES CLOSE FOR THIS SHOW.

Winning First Place in an Open Junior Showmanship Class at this show may qualify, or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes.
