

Suggestions for using the Creation to the Greeks planning page:

I print these pages on one sheet of paper (front and back) so that I can place it in a 3 ring binder and be able to flip the page to fill in the information on the 2nd page. I designed this form to be compact, and printing like this cuts down on the amount of paper that I have to keep up with. You will notice that there are places to fill in the students name, school year, and school name at the bottom of each page. I have 3 children in 2 different grades doing this Creation to the Greeks study, and I want to be able to keep a separate file for each child's records for the school year, therefore the need to be able to label each students planning pages individually. The information across the top of page 1 would be used as follows: "Week" - I consecutively number the weeks of the school year here; "Date" - I use the date for Monday of that week here; "Memory Verse" - I note the reference for the memory verse assigned for the week here.

The folder images beside some of the entries are used as a check box, i.e., if we have assigned work in that particular book/activity for the day then I place a check mark in the folder when I fill in the information on the blank. Below is a sample of how I would fill in information for each of the blanks on the form. I don't use every blank each school day, but I will for the example below.

"E.G. Lesson#" on this form is for Easy Grammar, which is what we are using this year. Pages 4 & 5 of this document contains a duplicate of this planning page, but I have removed the "E.G. Lesson#" field, and added a line for Language Arts for those of you not using Easy Grammar.
