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TEASER

FADE IN:

INT. ZACH'S OFFICE

ZACH is seated at his desk working on his computer, when SIVEA storms in. She has a P.D.A. in her hands, and she's not looking very happy.

SIVEA
(re: the P.D.A.)
Would you mind explaining this?

Zach reacts with a sheepish grin. He's been expecting Sivea to show up sooner or later.

ZACH
(innocently)
Ah, Commander. How nice of you to drop by. I was just working on --

But Sivea steps closer. She's not in the mood for games.

SIVEA
I asked you a question. What's this about?

ZACH
Oh, you mean the P.D.A.? Or the copy of the subspace message from Earth that I thought might be of interest to you.

SIVEA
(not amused)
Someone left this on the floor in front of my quarters. And something tells me that was you.

ZACH
(admitting)
That's possible. Yes, that's possible. I do remember being in that area earlier today.
(off her look, quickly)
I didn't wanna bother you while you were on duty. I know that you get pretty busy.

SIVEA
It's a request from some news network on Earth. They want me to confirm my life interview that's apparently been scheduled for next week. An interview with you.

ZACH
("innocent surprise")
Oh, is that next week? Time flies by, doesn't it? I was sure we still had at least two weeks.

SIVEA

(fed up)

I never agreed to do any kind of interview, and you know that.

Zach realizes he'll have to think fast to work this out in a beneficial way.

ZACH

Okay, okay. Now that you mention it... I actually did still want to talk to you about that.

SIVEA

The answer is no.

But Zach's not willing to let it go.

ZACH

Before you decide too quickly, I ask you to at least think about it.

(trying to convince her)

I mean, it's a great opportunity. I'm sure we'll attract millions of viewers.

SIVEA

Zach, in the last couple of months, how many times have you been trying to get me to do an interview?

Zach knows it's been many times.

ZACH

I really don't keep track of things like that. Maybe once or twice...

(off her glaring look)

Okay... maybe a little more than that.

SIVEA

A lot more than that. And what was my response every single time?

Zach doesn't want to admit it, but he has no choice.

ZACH

You said no.

SIVEA

Exactly. And just what in that twisted mind of yours could make you think that if I don't want to do an interview with you in the first place, I might want to do it in front of millions of people?

ZACH

(a guess)

Everyone desires their five minutes of fame?

Sivea steps a little closer. She shoves the P.D.A. into Zach's hands, as she tells him:

SIVEA

I don't.

With that she's about to head off, when Zach tries to appeal to her one more time.

ZACH

Sivea, please, you have to understand... it's my job to provide audiences with interesting and intriguing stories. And let's face it... your life's full of those.

She stops and turns to look at him again, as he goes on.

ZACH (CONT'D)

I mean, last year you were having visions about the future. And audiences aside here, I'm just pretty curious myself. Everyone probably wants to know what exactly happened there. And while we're at it, I'm also dying to know the details about you and Kalos confronting that syndicate a couple of months ago.

(sincere)

Forget about the life broadcast. But I'd be very grateful if you'd just give me a couple of minutes of your time.

Sivea considers his words for a moment. She then speaks softer, trying to make him understand.

SIVEA

This might come as a shock to you... but all of that are things I just don't want to talk about. And I'd appreciate it if you'd respect my privacy.

There's a beat. Zach is disappointed, but he accepts it, hearing in her voice that this is still a tender subject for her.

ZACH

(he means it)
I will.

SIVEA

You better.

And she EXITS. We hold on Zach, as he starts mumbling to himself.

ZACH

(mumbling)
Great. Good job, Zach. Way to go.

And off Zach's disappointment...

EXT. SPACE - HORIZON

Establishing the space station. We can see a VORIAN CARGO SHIP docked at one of the ramps.

INT. SIVEA'S QUARTERS

Sivea is dressed in civilian clothing. She's heading over to the couch with a cup filled with a beverage and a book in her hands. She's about to enjoy a quiet evening reading, but before she can sit down her door CHIMES.

SIVEA

Come in.

(then)

But if that's you, Zach, don't bother.

But then...

NEW ANGLE

as the door opens, and KALOS ENTERS. He's dressed in comfortable civilian clothing, and his features seem unusually warm and friendly. Sivea is completely caught off guard. But before she can say something:

KALOS

(friendly)

I hope you don't mind this surprise visit.

Sivea searches for words a beat. Kalos was clearly the last person she expected to see walking through that door.

SIVEA

What are you doing here?

KALOS

I just arrived on a cargo ship. I was coming by to see you.

SIVEA

That doesn't answer my question.

KALOS

(nods calmly)

Yes, of course.

Kalos thinks about his words for a beat. And when he speaks, he seems unusually sincere. His voice is filled with calmness.

KALOS (CONT'D)

I can understand that you'd be somewhat suspicious of me, despite of what we've been through. But let me assure you, Commander, I've spent these last couple of months... contemplating my life, trying to put things in order. And not a day went by on which I didn't thank the Originators. I thanked them for being alive... I thanked them for Ric'hell being alive. But all of a sudden I realized that I... never expressed my gratitude towards you. If it weren't for you, I'd still be sitting in my cell on Pelios. And my son would either be in the hands of the Syndicate... or he'd be dead.

(MORE)

KALOS (CONT'D)

(beat)

You've saved both of our lives. And
for that I want to say thank you.

Sivea regards Kalos in silence for a moment, taking in the fact that just perhaps he's changed. But she's not quite sure what to make of him just yet.

SIVEA

(tentatively)

You're welcome.

Kalos acknowledges. There's a silent beat between the two.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

Last I heard, you turned down
President Kohmar, when he offered
you to resume your position as
Minister of Security?

Kalos nods.

KALOS

I thought about it for a long time.
But... the truth is, after what
happened, I felt I couldn't just go
back to the way things used to be.

(off her look)

I felt it was time for me to settle
down, and finally spend some more
time with my family.

(soft)

Try to reconnect with my wife.

SIVEA

I do know that your family means a
lot to you.

KALOS

Yes... in a way it seems the two of
us know each other a lot better than
we're probably supposed to.

Sivea pauses at that strange thought, but she knows what he means.

KALOS (CONT'D)

Not too surprising, considering that
we... engaged in a Cai'nan blending.

There's a beat. Sivea looks at the man before her, and she does indeed know him pretty well.

SIVEA

You still haven't answered my
question.

(off his look)

I don't think you came here in person
just to say thank you.

Kalos smiles slightly at that. He can't deny it.

KALOS

You're right... I do need to ask you
a favor.

(off her curious look)

Before I settle down for good, there's
something I need to do. And I need
your help in order to pull it off.
I need your tactical background and
your experience.

SIVEA

What are you talking about?

KALOS

I'm about to go on a very important
mission. Something that's been fueled
by... a sense of patriotism.

(beat)

And I'd like for you to join me.

And off Sivea's reaction to the mysterious request, we...

FADE OUT.

ACT ONE

FADE IN:

(NOTE: Episode credits fall over opening scenes.)

INT. SIVEA'S QUARTERS - CONTINUOUS

Sivea takes in Kalos' words for a beat. She clearly doesn't know what to make of this.

SIVEA
(distrustfully)
What's that supposed to mean? What
kind of mission?

Kalos knows this request comes as a shock to her, as he goes on, explaining in his calm voice:

KALOS
I'm sure you're aware that there's a
strong possibility that there's still
active rogue cells in Kih'Andari
space. That the rouges may even
still have supporters in the
Kih'Andari Council.

SIVEA
(cautious)
I've heard the... rumors.

KALOS
I believe it's more than rumors.
(off her look)
I have some data pointing to the
fact of a rogue base being located
in the Ven'kora system.

Sivea is familiar with that area.

SIVEA
Ven'kora is deep inside Kih'Andari
territory.

Kalos nods.

KALOS
The Kih'Andari claim that they've
left that system months ago.
However... we've intercepted subspace
communication that was sent to
Ven'kora by a Kih'Andari ship near
the Vorian boarder.

This gets Sivea thinking. She's never believed that the Kih'Andari have been completely honest with the Vorians after the war ended.

SIVEA
Did you take any of this to the Vorian
government?

KALOS
Of course I did. But... let's just
say my concerns fell on deaf ears.

SIVEA

How so?

KALOS

President Kohmar is maintaining a regular contact with the Kih'Andari High Council, as I'm sure you know. The Kih'Andari High Council assures us that they don't know of any rogue bases.

SIVEA

(nodding thoughtfully)

But you think they're lying.

KALOS

I've never trusted this new High Council. The fact that they're not willing to let us help them in searching their space doesn't exactly help.

(thoughtful)

To tell you the truth, I was terrified the moment I learned that Vahret hadn't been reinstated.

SIVEA

Well, I wasn't surprised by it. After all, we had Vahret in custody for months.

KALOS

But you and I proved his innocence. That should have been enough for his people to allow him to resume his position as High Council.

(beat)

But both you and I know that this is nothing but a political power play -- one that's happening behind closed doors.

(worried)

Only the Originators know what else is going on in Kih'Andari space. For all we know they're already planning for the next war.

Sivea takes a beat to consider this. Regardless of whether or not she trusts Kalos, he has brought up something that's been worrying her for quite a while now.

SIVEA

Even if all of that is true... I don't see what you could do about it -- not without the support of the Vorian government.

KALOS

I disagree.

(off her look)

All we need is to take a ship to Ven'kora and begin scanning the area. Once we gather the evidence we need, we can take it to the Command Council.

(MORE)

KALOS (CONT'D)

Kohmar will have a hard time sitting on his hands with the proof right in front his eyes. And whatever the Kih'Andari are hiding in Ven'kora... we'll find out.

SIVEA

What if the Kih'Andari realize what you're doing?

KALOS

(correcting)

Don't you mean what we're doing?

(off her look)

Sivea, I would very much appreciate it if you joined me on this mission. And you know very well that provoking some kind of conflict with the Kih'Andari is the last thing I'd want. My concern has always been with the safety of the Vorian people, and that'll never change.

(beat)

Now, this has to be a mission off the books -- no involvement from the Space Command whatsoever. Officially Horizon can't have anything to do with this. That way if the Kih'Andari spot us, we'll be able to claim that we're merely a civilian ship traveling through that sector.

SIVEA

(incredulous)

Just what makes you think that I would actually agree to do this? Go on some kind of mission with you?!

Kalos hesitates a beat, almost looking like he's feeling a little hurt that she still seems to have a grudge against him. But he composes himself, and sticks to the facts.

KALOS

Because I know you care about the safety of the Vorian people as much as I do. You're a patriot -- that's what you and I have in common.

There's a beat. Sivea can't deny that.

KALOS (CONT'D)

(soft)

Don't get me wrong... I'm going to go on this mission regardless of what your decision is. But I'd feel a lot better if you'd come with me, because the truth is we have no idea what we'll run into.

(beat)

I'll be leaving in two days. I'll be on the station in the meantime.

And with that, Kalos turns and EXITS, leaving behind a very thoughtful Sivea.

We HOLD ON her as she thinks about his words, and then...

CUT TO:

EXT. SPACE - HORIZON

Re-establishing the space station. The Vorian ship, which we now know is Kalos' vessel, is still docked at one of the ramps.

INT. GYM

We see SEVERAL N.D.s working out here, using the various bikes, steppers, arm presses, lifting weights, etc. This is a typical gym. An area to which a lot of station inhabitants come on a regular basis.

We find Sivea and CHRISTINE here, both wearing their workout gear, doing their daily workout like they had in "What Fear Does." Christine is just finishing using some handles, while Sivea nearby has been doing some stretching. We can tell that Sivea's mind is somewhere else.

CHRISTINE

(mid conversation)

Well, maybe he's really just here for some downtime. For all we know he's serious about settling down.

(on second thought)

All right. That didn't sound too convincing, did it?

SIVEA

I know Kalos. And I find it hard to believe that he'd be willing to let go of everything he's been fighting for these past few years.

Christine puts down the handles, and heads over to Sivea.

CHRISTINE

(wry)

You mean like opposing the Earth/Vorian alliance, trying to get Horizon shut down.

SIVEA

Among other things.

Christine considers a beat.

CHRISTINE

Well, I guess for now we have no choice but to accept what he said.

(reading off Sivea's reaction)

Unless, of course, there was something you wanted to tell me.

Sivea looks at her with surprise. Christine smiles.

CHRISTINE (CONT'D)

Hey, I'm your friend. It's my job to know when there's something on your mind.

Sivea slightly smiles at that, appreciating it. She decides to tell her.

SIVEA

Kalos came to see me last night.

(off look)

He's afraid that the new powers that be in the Kih'Andari Council might be supporting the rouges. He thinks that there's an active rouges base in the Ven'kora system.

CHRISTINE

You think he's right?

SIVEA

(worried)

I think there's a good chance. A lot of us have put this thing behind us, pretending that the past two years never happened. But I think that it's wishful thinking to assume that the Kih'Andari are suddenly our peaceful neighbors.

CHRISTINE

Did you talk to Callen about this?

SIVEA

Not yet. I haven't made a decision yet.

(off her curious look)

Kalos is going on an off-the-books mission... to try and find proof that there's something going on in the Ven'kora system. He asked me to join him.

(unsure)

And to tell you the truth... part of me wants to.

CHRISTINE

(understanding)

Because you're concerned about what could happen if you don't do anything.

Beat. Sivea nods slightly.

CHRISTINE (CONT'D)

So what's holding you back?

SIVEA

(thoughtful)

I'm not sure. Maybe it's just the idea of doing this with Kalos.

(shaking head)

From having blended with him, I know his concern for the Vorian people is sincere. But... I think I've just gotten so used to... not trusting him... not even liking him, for that matter.

Christine considers for a moment, giving her a piece of advice.

CHRISTINE

Well, the way I see it, this isn't about Kalos... it's about you. And you just told me you're worried about the Kih'Andari. If you think there's a chance they're up to something... odds are you'd want to look into it.

There's a moment as Sivea slightly nods, appreciating the advice. And off this moment between the two friends...

INT. COMMANDER'S OFFICE

A surprised looking CALLEN is standing behind his desk.

CALLEN

Are you sure about this?

ADJUST TO INCLUDE Sivea standing before the desk.

SIVEA

(determined)

Trust me, I've thought about this for a long time... and the answer is yes. I hope you can understand my reasoning.

CALLEN

I can understand your reasoning. I'm just not sure if it's the right thing to do.

(explains)

If the Kih'Andari find out that we're spying on them behind their backs, we could destroy our diplomatic relationship with them. A relationship that the Governing Chamber and the President have been working very hard at maintaining.

SIVEA

And that's exactly why this can't be an official mission. I'll be joining Kalos as a civilian.

(persuasively)

Commander, you have to realize that we have no reason whatsoever to trust the Kih'Andari -- especially with Vahret no longer in power.

Callen paces slightly for a moment, thinking about what she said.

CALLEN

President Kohmar has made it clear that he doesn't want any action taken against the Kih'Andari -- not right now. Regardless of whether or not you and Kalos head into their space as civilians... you'd be going against the President's decision.

Sivea's not willing to leave it at that.

SIVEA

And do you agree with the President's decision?

CALLEN

That's not the issue.

SIVEA

I think it is. I'm not the only one who thinks that Kohmar's been too lenient with the Kih'Andari. Out of fear of provoking another war, he's practically been giving them free reign. We hardly have any contacts anymore in their Council, they've completely shut us out.

(beat)

Sir, all I'm asking is that we look into this. Hopefully we'll come to the conclusion that we have nothing to worry about.

Callen still doesn't like this, but he gives it some more thought.

CALLEN

If you do this... you'll be on your own. I can't risk sending anyone else. If you get captured for whatever reason... don't expect any help.

SIVEA

(confident)

I'm aware of that.

Callen looks at her in silence for a long beat. He's worried about letting her do this, clearly also concerned for her in a personal way. But she has convinced him.

CALLEN

(soft)

Just be careful.

SIVEA

(after a beat)

Thank you, sir.

A moment as they acknowledge. Then Sivea EXITS. And off Callen's thoughtful features...

EXT. SPACE - HORIZON

Re-establishing the space station. This time we're close on the upper central tower. We can see into the gate room through the glass dome behind the Stargate.

INT. CORRIDOR NEAR CONTROL ROOM

Sivea and GRANT ENTER from a lift. Sivea is now wearing civilian clothing, and they're walking down the corridor towards the control room.

GRANT

And you're absolutely sure you wanna do this?

SIVEA
(with determination)
It's either do this, or sit back and
hope for the best.

GRANT
Well, I know I won't be able to talk
you out of it, so... I'm not even
gonna try.

SIVEA
And I appreciate that.

GRANT
Still, I wish I'd be coming with
you.

SIVEA
Don't worry. I'm not planning on
staying long.

And they head into...

INT. CONTROL ROOM - CONTINUOUS

where the VORIAN TECHNICIAN is seated at his console. Sivea
and Grant join him.

VORIAN TECHNICIAN
(to Sivea)
We're just receiving word from the
Hen'gara. It's Kalos.

SIVEA
On screen.

The technician proceeds, and...

INCLUDE THE MAIN VIEWER

as it switches to showing Kalos on the Bridge of his Vorian
ship. He looks visibly pleased.

KALOS
Commander Ve'nal. I'm ready to head
off whenever you are.

Sivea and Grant exchange a subtle look, and then Sivea looks
at Kalos on the screen. It still feels odd to her to head
off with Kalos, and she's not quite sure what to expect.

And as we push in on her reaction, we...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO

FADE IN:

EXT. HYPERSPACE - THE VORIAN SHIP

We see the Vorian cargo ship as it cruises through the bright tunnel of hyperspace.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

This is a slightly redressed version of a regular Vorian bridge, looking very similar to the bridge of Der'ash's ship in late Season Three. Consoles are aligned around the room with a centered captain's chair in the middle of them. Present here we find Sivea and Kalos, as well as another Vorian; a man named BO'VIC. He's in his forties, also wearing civilian clothing, and he's manning the helm controls.

BO'VIC

(off console)

We're on course for the Ven'kora system. We'll arrive in approximately seven hours.

KALOS

(satisfied)

Thank you, Bo'vic.

Kalos turns to Sivea, who's glancing over one of the nearby consoles.

KALOS (CONT'D)

(to Sivea)

So what do you think of our little ship?

SIVEA

(looking at the readouts)

I see you made some upgrades.

KALOS

(nods)

Mainly to the propulsion systems, but we also have improved weapons as well as Asgard transporters.

SIVEA

(surprised)

Asgard transporters? On a cargo ship?

KALOS

Earth's been very generous with us in the past. Of course, it's not standard practice to have a cargo ship upgraded like this, but... fortunately I still have some valuable contacts.

SIVEA

Well, looks like you're prepared for emergencies.

Kalos acknowledges, catches that Sivea's pleasantly surprised by this. There's a beat.

KALOS

I've prepared quarters for you on deck two, section seven A. I hope you find them accommodating.

Sivea nods her appreciation.

SIVEA

Let me know if we run into any... surprises.

Kalos nods. Sivea's just about to exit, when --

KALOS

Commander.

She stops. Kalos hesitates very briefly, thinking about how to word what he's about to say.

KALOS (CONT'D)

Since it'll be a while until we arrive at Ven'kora... I was wondering if you had any plans for the next couple of hours.

SIVEA

(not sure what to make of the request)

I was just gonna spend some time in my quarters.

KALOS

(friendly)

Well, I'd appreciate it if you'd join me for dinner in the ship's mess this evening. I thought it could give us an opportunity to discuss our mission in a less... formal setting.

Sivea's caught off guard by the invitation. But she sees no reason to say no.

SIVEA

Sure... why not.

Kalos smiles, visibly happy.

KALOS

Then I'll see you at eighteen hundred hours.

Kalos walks over to the captain's chair, where he takes a seat. Sivea pauses for a moment, catching his pleased reaction. She considers a beat, but decides to not to read too much into it.

And off Kalos...

INT. VORIAN SHIP - MESS HALL

We find an unusual sight: Sivea and Kalos are having dinner together.

They're seated at one of the tables in the otherwise bare mess hall, enjoying a rather large and delicious looking meal, consisting of various Vorian cuisine. Kalos is just raising his glass, which is filled with a Vorian ale.

KALOS

(making a toast)

To our mission. May it be the first of many joined ventures, and a symbol of unity amongst our people.

Sivea acknowledges that statement, and the two take a sip of their drinks. And as they put their glasses down...

SIVEA

I have to say I'm surprised.

(off look)

I wasn't expecting this kind of a meal.

Kalos shakes it off.

KALOS

It's just something I picked up on Vorian before I left. I've always found it difficult to stay focused without a... good meal. Something my mother once taught me.

Sivea smiles at that. And then there's silence for a beat, as they both start eating.

KALOS (CONT'D)

(making conversation)

You know, there's something I've been wanting to ask you.

SIVEA

What's that?

KALOS

I know that Horizon played a vital role in ending the war with the Kih'Andari.

Sivea looks up at him, wondering where he's going with this.

KALOS (CONT'D)

It seems Callen did his people an enormous service.

Sivea is already switching into defensive mode, knowing Kalos very well.

SIVEA

What are you getting at?

Beat.

KALOS

There's a lot of us who believe that this peace with the Kih'Andari is only temporary.

(curious)

I was wondering what your take on it was.

Sivea hesitates to answer that. She's never directly been asked this before.

SIVEA

(evading)

A lot of our people seem to be hopeful.

KALOS

That wasn't my question.

Beat. Sivea decides to give him an honest answer.

SIVEA

I don't know. I hope the peace lasts, but... I'm the first to admit that it would seem a little too simple.

(shaking head)

You can't just bury the past and pretend it never happened.

KALOS

That sounds pretty much like what I was telling the President.

Sivea turns the questioning around.

SIVEA

I take it your disagreements with Kohmar are the reason you decided to give up your post as Minister of Security?

Now it is Kalos who hesitates, also facing a question no one's asked him before.

KALOS

President Adari and I had a great working relationship. We didn't always see eye to eye, but... she always valued my opinion. And I had a great deal of respect for her.

(with some regrets)

Truth is, I don't think I could ever develop that kind of a relationship with Kohmar. He's "softer" than Adari was... he may care about the safety of Vorian, but he's a pacifist. And I'm afraid of the day on which that'll get in his way.

SIVEA

I don't know Kohmar that well. But he seems like a reasonable man.

KALOS

I'm not questioning that. But it's no secret that he opposed Adari's decision to go to war with the Kih'Andari.

SIVEA

Maybe that wasn't such a bad thing.

KALOS

I don't believe that...

(knowing it)

... and neither do you.

(beat)

Just think if we hadn't gone to war...
the rogues might have done more with
their biogenic weapon than to just
attack the capital.

Sivea is silent. Kalos watches her for a beat. He gets more direct.

KALOS (CONT'D)

So what do you think? Did you support
the preemptive strike?

Kalos regards her, waiting for her reply. Sivea takes a beat, as she faces the past. And she decides to reveal something she's never told anyone before:

SIVEA

Back when Council Vahret came to the
station, and Commander Callen was
doing what he could to prevent a
war... part of me was hoping he
wouldn't be able to. And I was
actually relieved when we finally
did attack the Kih'Andari. Because
I knew there was no way around it.
It was devastating to see the peace
come to an end... but it was a
necessary evil as far as I was
concerned.

KALOS

(realizing)

But you didn't tell anyone how you
felt? I find that surprising.

(off her look)

You just seem like someone who...
always speaks her mind.

Sivea considers a moment -- he's right.

SIVEA

I remember sitting at that table
with Callen, negotiating with
Vahret... and I knew that if Vahret
wasn't going to start the war, someone
else would eventually rise to power...
and they'd launch an attack.

(beat)

But I have a great deal of respect
for Callen... and trust him --
implicitly. So I did know that if
anyone could find a peaceful
solution... it would be him.

There's a beat. Kalos can't help but smile slightly.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

(off his smile)

What's funny?

KALOS

Oh, nothing, it's just... I find it curious how you and I have more in common than we would have thought.

(blunt)

Except perhaps our implicit trust in De'van Callen's abilities.

Sivea's expression slightly darkens. She doesn't like hearing that.

SIVEA

I don't think you and I have as much in common as you think.

KALOS

I know we've had differing opinions in the past, and we still do. And make no mistake -- my views haven't changed. I still think Horizon is a mistake, and that Vorian should be sealing off its borders for the time being.

SIVEA

And effectively end our alliance with Earth...

KALOS

For our own good. We've never faced as many threats as we have these past few years, ever since we ran into the humans.

SIVEA

That kind of thinking is what led to the Kih'Andari secession in the first place.

KALOS

You know where I stand on the Kih'Andari -- better than anyone. But they were right about one thing... Vorian would have been better off on its own.

Sivea finds his words despicable, not to say hypocritical.

SIVEA

(accusingly)

How can you sit there saying that... while at the same time you have an Asgard transporter on your ship?! A technology that Vorian would have never gotten its hands on, had it not been for the humans.

KALOS

I'm not saying that there haven't been some benefits. But that doesn't make up for the down sides.

SIVEA

(with an edge)

The benefits outweigh any down sides you may see.

KALOS

Seems like we have a fundamental difference of opinion when it comes to that.

There's a beat as they're both silent. Then Kalos tries to ease the tension between them.

KALOS (CONT'D)

Either way -- there's no sense in dwelling on the past.

(soft)

Let's just hope our government will make the right calls from hereon in.

Sivea regards him for a moment, not willing to ignore their disagreement. But she decides to let it go for now.

Suddenly --

BO'VIC'S RADIO VOICE

Bo'vic to Kalos.

Kalos takes out his Vorian communicator, and activates it.

KALOS

Go ahead.

BO'VIC'S RADIO VOICE

Sir, we're approaching the Ven'kora system.

Sivea and Kalos exchange a look -- they're getting closer to the moment of truth.

KALOS

We'll be right up.

As Sivea and Kalos rise from the table, Kalos pauses. He looks at Sivea.

KALOS (CONT'D)

(sincere)

I enjoyed our meal. Thank you.

There's a beat as Sivea can see something in his eyes, a look that suggests some kind of deeper affection. But he turns away and EXITS. Sivea remains behind for a moment; she's not completely sure what to make of Kalos just yet.

And as she also EXITS...

EXT. HYPERSPACE - THE VORIAN SHIP

We see the vessel cruising through the hyperspace tunnel.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

Bo'vic is working his controls, as Sivea and Kalos ENTER.

KALOS

Report.

BO'VIC

Preparing to drop out of hyperspace.

KALOS
Raise shields.

Sivea turns to Kalos, giving her advice.

SIVEA
We should exit hyperspace outside
the solar system. As far away as
possible.

Kalos nods his understanding.

KALOS
That way it'll be easier to make them
believe we're just a civilian ship
that's come off course.
(to Bo'vic)
You heard the commander.

BO'VIC
Yes, sir.

Bo'vic works his controls in silence for a moment. Then --

BO'VIC (CONT'D)
Dropping out of hyperspace -- now.

EXT. SPACE - THE VORIAN CARGO SHIP

A hyperspace window opens before the backdrop of stars, and
the Vorian cargo ship emerges.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

As before.

BO'VIC
(working his controls)
I'm scanning the solar system.

Kalos stares out the front window. He has a tense expression
on his face.

KALOS
According to our information, the
base is located on the fourth planet.

Bo'vic acknowledges. There's a tense silence for a moment.
And suddenly, Bo'vic reacts with surprise to his readouts.

BO'VIC
Sir... this is strange.

KALOS
(tense)
What is it, Bo'vic?

Bo'vic double checks, then frowns.

BO'VIC
I'm not picking up anything on
sensors.

Kalos is caught off guard.

KALOS
What?!

SIVEA

Are you sure?

BO'VIC

I'm positive.

KALOS

Try the other habitable planets.

Bo'vic proceeds. Sivea shakes her head, as she reminds Kalos.

SIVEA

We knew it was just an assumption
that they'd have a base out here.

(hopeful)

Maybe we were a little premature
after all.

KALOS

(with a slight edge)

You'll forgive me, Commander, if I
don't share your optimism.

Before Sivea can reply, Bo'vic speaks with urgency in his
voice --

BO'VIC

(off console)

Sir -- there's a ship de-cloaking in
front of us.

Off Sivea and Kalos's surprise...

EXT. SPACE

We see a KIH'ANDARI ATTACK CRUISER dropping out of hyperspace.
The cruiser is of the same design as Der'ash's ship had been.
It's heading straight towards the considerably smaller Vorian
cargo ship.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

Everyone's attention is on the front viewing screen.

BO'VIC

(off console)

They have their weapons charged!

Kalos tenses up.

KALOS

(more to himself)

Looks like we came to the right place
after all.

SIVEA

But why would they attack a civilian
Vorian ship?

Suddenly --

BO'VIC

I'm picking up two more of them.

INCLUDE THE VIEWING SCREEN

as we see TWO MORE KIH'ANDARI FIGHTERS de-cloaking. The three identical looking vessels are approaching in attack formation.

RESUME

to include their tense reactions.

SIVEA

(grim)

Well, they're clearly violating the treaty by using their cloaking technology.

Kalos is feeling a little unsettled now. He's not used to being in a situation like this.

KALOS

(to Sivea)

What do we do?

SIVEA

We don't stand a chance against three of them. We need to get out of here.

Kalos nods quickly.

KALOS

(to Bo'vic)

You heard her.

Bo'vic works his controls.

BO'VIC

Preparing to jump back into hyperspace.

But then --

BO'VIC (CONT'D)

They're attacking...

Sivea reacts quickly, taking charge.

SIVEA

Maximum power to shields!

And as Bo'vic proceeds...

EXT. SPACE

The formation of three Kih'Andari Fighters approach the Vorian cargo ship. And before the cargo ship can jump into hyperspace, the Kih'Andari Fighters OPEN FIRE, discharging Draque weapons blasts.

And as the cargo ship takes some hits, we...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT TWO

ACT THREE

FADE IN:

EXT. SPACE

Continuous action... the Kih'Andari Fighters are attacking the Vorian cargo ship, landing several hits.

ON THE CARGO SHIP

as it takes hits, most of which are absorbed by its shields.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

The ship is ROCKED. Sparks crack in some corners, and the lighting flickers slightly. Kalos reacts with slight panic; he's not a man used to combat.

KALOS

(urgent)

What are you waiting for, Bo'vic?
We need to get out of here!

The ship takes another HIT.

BO'VIC

(off console)

They've disabled our engines, sir.
Hyperdrive is off-line. We're not
going anywhere.

There's a tense beat as Kalos looks to Sivea. Sivea doesn't like how this is going, but she quickly jumps into action, instinctively taking charge.

SIVEA

(with determination)

Then we'll fight.

(to Bo'vic)

Focus on evasive maneuvers, and fire
all weapons on automatic. Target
their hyperdrive engines.

Kalos realizes.

KALOS

You're trying to disable their
engines...

SIVEA

Actually, if we land a few good hits
I'm hoping we can detonate their
hyperdrive -- it's either them or
us.

Kalos nods his understanding, as Sivea turns to Bo'vic again.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

Do it.

BO'VIC

(proceeding)

Understood.

The ship is ROCKED again, as we go to...

EXT. SPACE

The Vorian ship is flying some evasive maneuvers, as it returns fire. This vessel is equipped with standard Vorian PHASIAL DISCHARGERS.

VARIOUS ANGLES

as the three Kih'Andari Fighters never break formation, and keep attacking. However, the center fighter begins taking some hits as well now.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

The ship is taking some more HITS. And a console in the back BLOWS OUT, causing flames to emerge from it.

BO'VIC
(off console)
Shields down to forty percent.

Suddenly, Bo'vic reacts to something on his readouts that confuses him.

BO'VIC (CONT'D)
This isn't right...

SIVEA
What is it?

BO'VIC
Only one of the three fighters is directly attacking us. The others are firing their weapons, but it doesn't even seem like they're trying to hit us.

Sivea isn't sure what to make of that.

KALOS
Why would they do that?

But Sivea's already considering a possibility.

SIVEA
We can't worry about that right now...
I think I may be able to improve our odds.

She moves over to a nearby CONSOLE, and starts working some controls. The ship is ROCKED again.

KALOS
What are you doing?

SIVEA
(working the console)
Just making some slight modifications to our weapons.

Suddenly --

BAM! A part of Bo'vic's console EXPLODES, and he's blasted back, taking some burns. Kalos reacts with concern --

KALOS
Bo'vic!

Kalos rushes to Bo'vic, quickly checking his pulse -- he's alive. Kalos reacts with relief. The ship is ROCKED again. Kalos turns to Sivea.

KALOS (CONT'D)

Commander...

Sivea finishes working the console, and now quickly moves over to take over what's left of Bo'vic's console.

SIVEA

I've rerouted power from non essential systems to our weapons. That'll give them a little more juice temporarily.

(adding)

It's kind of an old trick, but it works every time.

KALOS

Every time?

SIVEA

(on second thought)

Almost every time.

The ship is ROCKED again.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

You better find something to hold onto.

Kalos nods quickly, as he grabs hold of the nearby captain's chair. Sivea hits a few controls.

And then --

SIVEA (CONT'D)

Here goes...

As she discharges the modified weapons...

EXT. SPACE - CLOSE ON THE VORIAN SHIP

There's a HUMMING SOUND as its weapons charge beyond their normal limit. And suddenly... the vessel FIRES SEVERAL BLASTS.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

The ship ROCKS MORE EXTENSIVELY this time. Despite of Kalos holding on, he's knocked to the ground. Sivea is grabbing onto her console. The light flickers.

EXT. SPACE

The three Kih'Andari ships are still flying in perfect formation (a little too perfect perhaps), as the Vorian cargo ship's weapons blasts only target the centered Kih'Andari ship.

And then...

CLOSE ON THE CENTERED KIH'ANDARI SHIP

as it takes some direct hits to its hyperdrive, and before we know it... it EXPLODES in a massive fireball. Burning debris are sent off in all directions.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

The shaking has subsided, but the lighting is dark now. There's a beat... then the EMERGENCY LIGHTING COMES ON... it's darker than the bridge's usual lighting.

Kalos is slowly getting back to his feet. He catches his bearings.

KALOS

What happened...?

EXT. SPACE

We see the burning debris of the Kih'Andari ship with the two other Kih'Andari ships nearby, still in formation. But then something strange happens:

The two other Kih'Andari ships VANISH INTO THIN AIR... like they were never there in the first place.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

Sivea is checking her readouts, looking a little baffled. Kalos steps forward.

KALOS

(insistent)

Sivea.

SIVEA

(off console)

Discharging the weapons overloaded some of our systems, but... we've destroyed one of the Kih'Andari ships.

(looking up)

The other two just... disappeared.

Kalos isn't sure what she means.

KALOS

What do you mean -- they disappeared?

SIVEA

(shaking head)

They're gone...

KALOS

Did they jump into hyperspace?

SIVEA

No. They were never really there.

She hits a few other controls.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

(off readouts)

There was never more than one ship
out there... what we picked up was a
sensor ghost. An illusion.

(she has to admit)

Not a bad trick at all.

But Kalos is confused.

KALOS

Why would they do something like
that?

Sivea holds a beat, tries to come up with an answer. But
she has none.

SIVEA

I think the real question is... why
did they attack us without provocation
in the first place?

And off her worried expression...

EXT. SPACE - THE VORIAN CARGO SHIP

The vessel is now hanging motionless in space. We can see
several scorch marks on its hull.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - ENGINE ROOM

This is a cramped room with VARIOUS CONSOLES. Sivea is here,
working on one of the consoles, running some diagnostics, as
Kalos ENTERS. He has a relieved expression on his face.

KALOS

I can happily say I have at least
some good news... Bo'vic's injuries
were minor. He's eager to resume
his post again.

Sivea acknowledges.

SIVEA

That's good to hear.

KALOS

(with some admiration)

He's one of the most loyal people
I've ever worked with.

(then, down to business)

Have you been making progress here?

SIVEA

Looks like the damage to our engines
wasn't as severe as we thought. I'm
by no means an engineer, but I know
enough about these systems to get
them running again. We should have
hyperdrive back online in a couple
of hours.

KALOS

(pleased)

More good news, then.

SIVEA

(grim)

Maybe. But our com system's still down, and it's not salvageable... which means we can't contact Horizon and ask for reinforcements. So we better hope there's no more Kih'Andari ships in the area.

Kalos considers that grim statement a beat.

KALOS

Why do you think they attacked us?
(shaking head)
They obviously don't seem to have a base in this system...

Sivea's been considering a possibility.

SIVEA

The fact that they were using Draque cloaking technology, despite that our agreement with them prohibits either of us from doing so... that tells me that whoever was on that ship, didn't care too much about the agreement.

KALOS

(understanding)
So we can assume they were rogues.

SIVEA

(nods)
Looks like you were right.

KALOS

But that still doesn't explain why they would attack a Vorian cargo ship without provocation.

SIVEA

I've been thinking about this. What's the number one thing that the rogues probably want?

KALOS

(realizing)
Another war...

SIVEA

Exactly. It's possible that they were trying to make it look like the Kih'Andari were the behind the attack.

KALOS

If you're right... then this is only the start.

(worried)
They'll be attacking more of our ships.

SIVEA

We need to let Horizon know what happened here.

But Kalos has other plans. It's something he's been wanting to bring up.

KALOS
Actually... I was hoping you weren't planning on going back to Horizon just yet.

Sivea is surprised by his statement.

SIVEA
What are you talking about? There's no more reason for us to stay out here -- obviously there's no rogues base here, and we've ran out of leads to follow.

But Kalos smiles slightly; he's not told her everything yet.

KALOS
That's not quite correct.

Sivea gives him a confused look. Kalos gestures to another console nearby.

KALOS (CONT'D)
I've taken the liberty of running some scans of the Kih'Andari ship -- let's call it an intuition. And I was able to procure the ship's data recording device from the debris.

SIVEA
(surprised)
In tact?

KALOS
Not quite. But I did manage to download what little data was still left into our computer.

He starts working the console.

INCLUDE A NEARBY VIEWING SCREEN

as it starts showing GRAPHICS that outline the Kih'Andari ship's flight route.

KALOS (CONT'D)
And I was able to determine where the ship came from.

Sivea is pleasantly surprised by this.

SIVEA
Good job.

Kalos points at the screen.

KALOS
Looks like its last stop was a planet in the Lasarian system, which is well outside of both Vorian and Kih'Andari space. That would make it likely that the rogues moved their base there.

SIVEA

You're probably right.

Sivea hits a few controls on the console, checks some readouts.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

(off readouts)

It'll take us about four hours to get to the Lasarian system at maximum speed.

KALOS

(satisfied)

Then that's our next stop.

Sivea thinks about this for a beat. Kalos can see that she's not certain yet, so he tries to convince her.

KALOS (CONT'D)

We need to obtain substantial evidence that supports that the rogues have a base out there. And both you and I know that as soon as they find out we destroyed one of their ships, it's likely they'll be evacuating that base and moving to a new location.

Sivea knows he's right. She considers an idea.

SIVEA

There's a good chance that they'll already have left the base by the time our government will get permission from the Kih'Andari Council to take any kind of action.

KALOS

That is -- if that will happen at all.

(he realizes she has an idea)

What are you thinking?

SIVEA

What if we plant a tracker on one of the rogues' ships? With any luck, we'll be able to see where they're heading if and when they leave their base.

KALOS

(surprised)

You think that's possible?

SIVEA

There's only one way to find out.

There's a beat, as they exchange a nod -- they're in agreement.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

All right. If we're gonna do this, we do it right.

(MORE)

SIVEA (CONT'D)

I'll need some time to make sure all our weapons are back to a hundred percent -- just in case things don't go so smoothly.

KALOS

Sounds like a plan.

(beat)

I'll be on the bridge, keeping an eye out for approaching ships.

Sivea nods her acknowledgment. And as Kalos EXITS, she gets back to work on the console. And off that...

CUT TO:

EXT. HYPERSPACE - THE VORIAN SHIP

The ship is cruising through hyperspace once again.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

Sivea is now manning the helm console. Kalos is standing at a console nearby.

SIVEA

(off console)

We're approaching the Lasarian system.

Kalos checks some readouts on his console.

KALOS

(off console)

I'd say congratulations are in order, Commander. You've made some excellent improvements to the ship's power distribution systems. I've never seen anything quite like it.

Sivea shakes it off, remembering the friend who taught her to do that.

SIVEA

(a little solemn)

Just a little trick a friend of mine taught me once.

Kalos nods slightly. His features seem thoughtful for a moment. Then he decides to bring something up:

KALOS

Sivea...

She looks at him.

KALOS (CONT'D)

(soft)

I just... I wanted to thank you for doing this. I really appreciate your being here.

(beat)

If you hadn't been here when that Kih'Andari ship attacked us...

SIVEA
(don't mention it)
We both want the same thing.

KALOS
But still... you've saved my life
twice now. Not that I'm counting or
anything.

There's a beat. Sivea can see that he is truly grateful.
And then --

BO'VIC (O.S.)
Sir?

They turn to see...

NEW ANGLE

Bo'vic ENTERS. He has some bandages on his hands and on his
forehead, covering his burn wounds. But he stands up firmly,
regarding Kalos.

BO'VIC (CONT'D)
Permission to resume my post.

KALOS
Are you sure you're up to it?

BO'VIC
(without a doubt)
Yes, sir.

Kalos smiles slightly, not surprised by Bo'vic's loyalty.

KALOS
Then resume your station, Mister
Bo'vic.

Bo'vic acknowledges. He steps forward, and Sivea stands,
letting him resume the helm controls. Bo'vic has a determined
look on his face, a hundred percent committed to the mission.

There's a beat of silence. And then...

BO'VIC
(off console)
We're arriving at our destination.

Sivea and Kalos exchange a look.

KALOS
The moment of truth...

Sivea agrees. She turns to Bo'vic.

SIVEA
Take us out of hyperspace.

And as Bo'vic proceeds...

EXT. SPACE

The Vorian cargo ship exits hyperspace.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

As before.

SIVEA
(to Bo'vic)
Take us to the outer planet and hold
our position there.

Bo'vic nods as he keeps working his controls. Kalos steps forward, a look of anticipation on his face.

KALOS
Anything on sensors?

Beat. Bo'vic focuses on his console.

BO'VIC
(off console)
I've got something. Some kind of
facility on the fifth planet... I'm
unable to determine if it's a
Kih'Andari base.

SIVEA
Life signs?

BO'VIC
(off console)
Several...
(looking up)
They're Vorian.

KALOS
Looks like we've found what we're
looking for.

SIVEA
Are there any ships in the vicinity?

Bo'vic works his controls for another moment. Then he shakes his head.

BO'VIC
Negative. There is one on the
planet's surface. And I'm picking
up traces of naquadah inside the
facility...
(beat)
It's a Stargate.

SIVEA
(considers)
If they've got a gate, there's a
chance they'll be able to evacuate
the base even quicker.

KALOS
Then I say we stick to our plan.

They exchange a look. Sivea nods her agreement. She has a look of determination on her face, ready to do what it takes.

And off that...

EXT. FOREST - DAY

A tight forest on the surface of the planet. This looks like a rather cold location. Trees and bushes are seen everywhere.

The flash of an ASGARD TRANSPORTER BEAM appears, as Sivea and Kalos materialize. They're both armed with Phasial Discharger Rifles, and Kalos is also carrying a small duffel bag. They've both got their rifles trained, as they secure the area. Then Kalos looks to Sivea, who's now examining the area with a Vorian scanner. She gestures forward.

SIVEA

This way.

As they slowly start moving through the forest, Kalos can't help but glance at the rifle in his hand.

KALOS

(re: the rifle)

Well -- it's certainly been a while since last I've held one of these in my hands.

SIVEA

(only half joking)

You sure you're able to use it?

KALOS

(wry)

I know how to aim and pull the trigger, if that's what you're asking.

SIVEA

That's good enough for me.

They keep moving forward in silence for a moment, as we...

TIME DISSOLVE TO:

EXT. FOREST - A LEDGE - DAY

Sivea and Kalos arrive at a ledge, from where they can overlook the area ahead. They carefully take position, lying down on the ground, surrounded by trees and bushes. And as they look at what lies ahead:

NEW ANGLE TO REVEAL:

a METALLIC BUILDING COMPLEX inside of the forest. The building is circular with small windows featured in various places, and it is surrounded by a large BARBWIRE FENCE. Inside the premise we can see a KIH'ANDARI FIGHTER that's landed next to the building complex; part of the fighter is behind the building, which means that from this point of view we cannot see the entire ship. SEVERAL KIH'ANDARI are walking around. They're all wearing the black suits that we've seen on Kih'Andari in the past.

ON SIVEA AND KALOS

as they take in the sight before them.

SIVEA

(sotto)

Definitely looks like a rogues base
to me.

And off that, we...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT THREE

ACT FOUR

FADE IN:

EXT. FOREST - AT THE LEDGE - DAY

Moments later... Sivea is taking a scan of the area, while Kalos is looking tense, not taking his eyes off of the rogues base ahead. Throughout this they both speak quietly, almost whispering.

SIVEA

(off scanner)

The good news is -- that's the only ship they have here.

KALOS

How many life signs?

SIVEA

That's where things get a little tricky... I'm picking up thirty-four. There's five of them in the room with the Stargate, which is located in the center of the building.

There's a beat as they both consider their options.

KALOS

Well, there's too many of them walking around the premise...

(ready to call this off)

I don't think we'll be able to plant any trackers.

But Sivea's not about to give up that quickly.

SIVEA

Give me that bag.

Kalos hands her the duffel bag, and she takes out a small DEVICE -- it's the tracker.

KALOS

(realizing)

You actually intend to go through with this?

SIVEA

(determined)

I don't know about you, but I didn't come all this way for nothing.

KALOS

How do you intend to sneak past them? If they spot you there's a chance they'll kill you before Bo'vic can beam us out.

She checks the tracking device, making sure it's ready. Then she points down at the premise.

SIVEA

You see that area back there?

She points at a part of the barbwire fence that's partially inside some bushes.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

I'll be able to cut through the fence and stay covered behind the trees. I just need to get close enough to plant the tracker... and we're out of here.

Kalos looks at her, genuinely concerned.

KALOS

What if you get caught? If for some reason we can't beam you out...?

SIVEA

Then the only thing you can do is make sure you get out of here. You'll have to head back to Horizon, and tell them what happened.

They hold a beat. Kalos is looking anything but confident about this, but he pulls himself together, trusting Sivea's judgment.

KALOS

(soft)
All right. All right.

And then...

CLOSE ON SIVEA

as she turns to face the base ahead, studying the premise. And as she's carefully plotting her moves...

DISSOLVE TO:

EXT. FOREST - THE ROUGES' BASE - DAY

We see TWO KIH'ANDARI walking by right in front of the building complex. They're both armed with Phasial Discharger rifles. As they move away, we...

PAN OVER TO SEE:

NEW ANGLE

Sivea is approaching the barbwire fence with her rifle trained. She's moving carefully through some very tight bushes, until she takes position right in front of the fence.

ON SIVEA

as she secures the area. Then she takes out her scanner, keeping track of the Kih'Andari's positions.

CLOSE ON A KIH'ANDARI GUARD

standing nearby the complex. We cannot tell where exactly he is in relation to Sivea. But it seems he's close.

BACK ON SIVEA

as she trains her rifle again. She hits a couple of settings on the weapon, and then FIRES a straight and continuous energy blast at the fence before her. We can see that the blast is cutting a hole into the fence.

After a moment, Sivea stops firing, and removes the part of the fence that she's cut out. She keeps her rifle trained, as she moves forward, entering the premise through the hole.

ON THE KIH'ANDARI GUARD

as he suddenly turns around. He's heard something.

ON SIVEA

as she's moved closer to the building complex now. She's staying covered behind some more trees and bushes, as she carefully moves forward, rifle trained.

THE KIH'ANDARI GUARD

narrows his eyes. He decides to check on what he heard. He slowly moves forward, passing a corner, and...

NEW ANGLE

as the Kih'Andari Guard looks around.

HIS P.O.V.

looking at an area next to the building complex. Nothing and no one can be seen here.

RESUME

as the Kih'Andari Guard frowns. Looks like he was mistaken.

BACK AT THE LEDGE

Kalos is watching through small binoculars that he's taken out of the duffel bag. He's trying to keep his nervousness contained. He's a man not used to being in these kind of situations, and his demeanor makes that clear.

EXT. THE ROUGES' BASE - DAY

Sivea is carefully moving forward, staying covered. She's in soldier mode, completely focused on the task, ready to act in the case of any surprises.

There's a tense beat. Then she moves around a corner, where she sees --

THE KIH'ANDARI SHIP

It's sitting very close by, and there are TWO ARMED KIH'ANDARI standing in front of the ship, guarding it. It has its landing gear extended, so there's some space between the ship's bottom and the ground.

ON SIVEA

as she's crouched down behind the corner. She again checks her scanner, making sure there's no other Kih'Andari in the area.

And then, she looks up again, studies the two guards for a moment. She trains her rifle on them, and --

She FIRES two well aimed shots. Both Kih'Andari take a respective hit, and are blasted to the ground, where they remain stunned.

Sivea knows she'll need to act quickly. She takes another glance at her scanner. She's clear. She then quickly leaves her cover, and begins running towards the Kih'Andari ship.

EXT. FOREST - AT THE LEDGE - DAY

Kalos is still watching through the binoculars.

BINOCULAR P.O.V.

looking at the back half of the Kih'Andari ship. Sivea is now out of sight.

RESUME

as Kalos lowers his binoculars. He knows all he can do now is wait and hope for the best.

EXT. THE ROUGES' BASE - AT THE KIH'ANDARI SHIP - DAY

Sivea is running towards the ship, keeping her rifle trained. As she arrives at the ship, she again secures her position. And then she takes the tracking device out of her pocket.

She hits a button on the tiny device, activating it. A couple of lights on its side begin to lighten up, telling us that the tracker is now transmitting.

Sivea moves underneath the ship's bottom, and she ATTACHES the tracker to the ship's hull. She places it so that no one will be able to see it while the ship's still landed.

Sivea is satisfied, having completed this part of the task. Now all she needs to do is get out without getting caught. She's just about to turn and head off, when suddenly --

ANOTHER ANGLE

The Kih'Andari Guard from earlier approaches her. He's got his own rifle trained, aiming it at Sivea.

Sivea freezes. She reacts quickly, wanting to train her rifle on him, but it's clear that he's about to pull the trigger.

KIH'ANDARI GUARD

Don't move!

Sivea knows he'd be able to shoot before she could. The Kih'Andari Guard steps a little closer, gestures at her rifle.

KIH'ANDARI GUARD (CONT'D)

Drop it.

Sivea narrows her eyes, but she knows she has no choice. She drops her rifle to the ground, and raises her hands.

There's a tense beat as the Kih'Andari Guard looks at her, recognizing her.

KIH'ANDARI GUARD (CONT'D)

I know who you are...

SIVEA

(convincingly)

Nice try, I'm flattered. But that's unlikely.

KIH'ANDARI GUARD

(studying her for a moment, making sure)

You're Sivea Ve'nal -- from the Horizon station.

(a tense beat)

What are you doing here?

And as Sivea gives him a defying look...

EXT. FOREST - AT THE LEDGE - DAY

Kalos is still waiting tensely. Sivea's still out of his visual range, and he's starting to realize that this is taking longer than expected. He's getting the feeling that something went wrong.

Off his worried features...

EXT. THE ROUGES' BASE - AT THE KIH'ANDARI SHIP - DAY

The Kih'Andari Guard is training his rifle on Sivea, who's looking at him defiantly.

KIH'ANDARI GUARD

(firm)

I asked you a question -- what are you doing here?

SIVEA

(wry)

I just went for a little walk in the forest. How about yourself?

The Kih'Andari Guard scowls.

KIH'ANDARI GUARD

Very well. If you won't talk to me... perhaps you'll talk to my commander.

There's another tense beat. So far the Kih'Andari Guard hasn't noticed the tracker, and Sivea knows that as long as that's the case they'll still be able to go through with the plan.

The Kih'Andari Guard is just about to reach for his communicator, when --

He stops. Looks up at something above Sivea. He suddenly sees the small device attached to the ship's hull, and realizes what it is.

He glances at Sivea again.

KIH'ANDARI GUARD (CONT'D)

Step back.

SIVEA

What's wrong?

KIH'ANDARI GUARD

Move!

Another tense beat. Sivea reluctantly does as she's told. The Kih'Andari Guard steps forward until he stands right underneath the tracker.

But what he doesn't notice is that Sivea's now standing underneath a SHAFT. The bars are large enough for her to hold onto them, and she's aware of this.

The Kih'Andari Guard gives her a slight grin, realizing that he's thwarted her plan. He's just about to reach for the tracker, when --

Sivea -- her hands still raised -- HOLDS ONTO the shaft above her, and SWINGS FORWARD, giving the Kih'Andari Guard a KICK.

THE KIH'ANDARI GUARD

is caught off guard. He DROPS his rifle, as he falls backward. He gets back on his feet quickly, reaching for his communicator again. But before he can radio anyone --

SIVEA

approaches him quickly, and TACKLES him. She gives him a STRAIGHT PUNCH, knocking him back again. He tries to retaliate, as Sivea evades his blow, and now gives him an IMPRESSIVE MARTIAL ARTS KICK.

The Kih'Andari is knocked back once again. The two are now no longer underneath the ship, as --

ON SIVEA AND THE KIH'ANDARI GUARD

Sivea approaches again, but this time the Kih'Andari Guard reacts faster, and manages to give her a KICK himself. It seems he has some notable fighting skills as well.

The Kih'Andari Guard now advances on Sivea, landing some hits. But then, Sivea begins to block again, and turns things around once more. She uses some rather impressive moves, as she lands more goodblows.

The Kih'Andari Guard is bleeding from his lip, as he's starting to grow angry. He uses his rage, and tackles Sivea again. The two begin to wrestle for several moments, as...

BACK AT THE LEDGE

We find an uneasy Kalos, aware that this has been taking way too long. Kalos is starting to consider options, feeling he has to do something.

CUT TO:

EXT. THE ROUGES' BASE - AT THE KIH'ANDARI SHIP - DAY

Sivea and the Kih'Andari Guard are still wrestling with each other. But then, Sivea gains the upper hand, and she TWISTS the Kih'Andari Guard's arm, before giving him several HARD BLOWS.

Then --

CLOSE ON SIVEA

as in SLOW MOTION we see her LEAPING at the guard, using another MARTIAL ARTS MOVE, and giving the Kih'Andari Guard a STRAIGHT KICK TO THE HEAD.

We resume in NORMAL SPEED as the Kih'Andari Guard is smashed to the ground. He stirs, as Sivea quickly GRABS her rifle again, and then --

THE KIH'ANDARI GUARD

tries to get back on his feet, when --

SIVEA

adjusts the setting on the rifle, and FIRES A SHOT.

THE KIH'ANDARI GUARD

takes a hit to the chest, where the blast leaves a wound. He's knocked to the ground -- dead.

BACK ON SIVEA

as she quickly secures the area, in full soldier mode. Hold for a tense beat. No one else is in the area.

Sivea glances back at the ship, knowing that the tracker should be hidden well enough.

And off Sivea's focused expression...

CUT TO:

EXT. FOREST - AT THE LEDGE - DAY

Sivea's on her way back. As she arrives at the ledge, she's naturally expecting to find Kalos. However --

Kalos is nowhere to be seen!

Sivea reacts with worry.

SIVEA
(quietly)
Kalos...

She taps her earpiece.

SIVEA (CONT'D)
Kalos, can you hear me?

No response. Beat. She taps the earpiece again.

SIVEA (CONT'D)
Kalos -- come in!

Nothing again. And then... Sivea reacts to something outside of our view. She realizes they're in trouble.

SIVEA'S P.O.V. - LOOKING AT THE ROUGES' BASE

to see that two N.D. KIH'ANDARI GUARDS are escorting an unarmed Kalos towards the building complex.

They're just walking through the main gate, and the Kih'Andari have their weapons trained on Kalos. One of the Guards is carrying the duffel bag. Even from the distance we can tell that Kalos is looking uneasy -- he knows he's in some serious trouble.

RESUME

as Sivea keeps her cover, watching what's happening before her.

SIVEA (CONT'D)
(to herself)
Great...

SIVEA'S P.O.V. - LOOKING AT THE ROUGES' BASE

the Guards and Kalos have now arrived at the entrance to the metallic building complex. One of the Kih'Andari emerges from the building; he's the man in charge, also wearing a black uniform. We'll come to know him as VELIS (40s), and he's a man who has a cold and savage expression on his face.

Velis regards Kalos. We can't hear what they're saying to each other, but it's clear that Kalos is trying to explain that this is some kind of mistake.

But Velis isn't buying it. Instead, he steps up to Kalos and gives him a HARD AND BRUTAL SMASH to the face. Kalos almost goes down, but the Kih'Andari Guards are supporting him.

ON SIVEA

as she winces at the sight of Kalos getting hit.

SIVEA'S P.O.V. - LOOKING AT THE ROUGES' BASE

to see that Kalos is now being led into the base. Velis remains outside for a beat. And as he also heads back into the building...

CLOSE ON SIVEA

as she knows Kalos is about to be interrogated. And off her concerned look, we...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT FOUR

ACT FIVE

FADE IN:

EXT. SPACE - THE VORIAN CARGO SHIP

The vessel is orbiting the planet.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

Bo'vic is at his console, talking to Sivea on the radio. He looks worried.

BO'VIC

How could this have happened?

SIVEA'S RADIO VOICE

There's no time to explain. I need you to lock onto Kalos' tracker and get him out of there.

Bo'vic nods quickly.

BO'VIC

All right. I'm on it.

There's a beat, then he looks up.

BO'VIC (CONT'D)

I can't get a lock.

INTERCUT WITH:

EXT. FOREST - AT THE LEDGE - DAY

where Sivea reacts.

SIVEA

Why not?

BO'VIC'S RADIO VOICE

There's some kind of disturbance field in place that prevents transportation. It wasn't there before.

SIVEA

Sounds familiar...

BO'VIC'S RADIO VOICE

They must have activated it when they captured Kalos.

Sivea takes this in. She glances back at the facility. And off her concerned look...

INT. KIH'ANDARI INTERROGATION ROOM - DAY

A darkly lit room with no windows. The only light is coming from a VERY BRIGHT LAMP in the center of the room, underneath which Kalos is sitting on a chair with his hands tied behind his back. He's now sporting several bruises, and blood is dripping from his mouth. The two N.D. Kih'Andari Guards are standing at the door, as it opens and Velis ENTERS.

Velis steps forward in the shadows, studies Kalos coldly for a beat.

VELIS

(shaking head)

It's such a shame... that a man like
you had to sink so deeply.

We only now see Kalos up close, and realize just how badly he's been beaten -- it's not a pretty sight. Parts of his face are swollen, and he can barely see from one eye.

KALOS

(weakly)

I... I don't know... what you mean...

VELIS

You've brought this on yourself, you
know.

KALOS

I've already told your... your men
that I... don't know anything. You're
wasting your time.

VELIS

That's unlikely.

(beat)

Two of my men were found unconscious
on our premise earlier -- one of
them was found dead.

Velis waits for a reaction from Kalos. But when there is none:

VELIS (CONT'D)

So it's obvious that you weren't
working alone. I want to know who
else is here.

KALOS

(quietly)

I don't know anything...

VELIS

I have people heading out right now.
They'll capture whoever was with
you.

(beat)

And you...

Velis leans in close to Kalos' face.

VELIS (CONT'D)

(threatening)

... I know you're not the kind of
man who's trained for this. It's
only a matter of time until... you'll
break.

And with that, Velis gives Kalos another BRUTAL SMASH to his face. Kalos cries out in pain.

VELIS (CONT'D)

(shouting)

I want answers!

He PUNCHES Kalos to the stomach. Kalos begins to cough. Velis regards him coldly, as Kalos gasps for air.

CUT TO:

EXT. FOREST - AT THE LEDGE - DAY

As before. Sivea is determined to take action. We intercut with Bo'vic on the Bridge as needed.

SIVEA

(determined)

Well, I'm not willing to leave him behind. I'll have to try and extract him myself.

But Bo'vic doesn't like that idea.

BO'VIC

I don't think that's a viable option. You'll just end up getting captured too... We need to leave, and come back with reinforcements.

SIVEA

If we do that, there's no telling what they'll do to him in the meantime.

BO'VIC

Yes -- that's true. But honestly... the way I know Kalos, he'd want us to keep the bigger picture in mind.

Sivea realizes he has a point, but she doesn't like it.

BO'VIC (CONT'D)

I don't like this any more than you do, Commander -- but I believe we can't risk you getting caught as well. You need to get out of the field's range, so that I can beam you onboard.

Sivea's still undecided. But before Sivea can reply --

ANOTHER ANGLE

WEAPONS BLASTS barely miss her. She turns to find SEVERAL KIH'ANDARI approaching from down the forest.

Sivea quickly takes cover, as MORE WEAPONS BLASTS are headed her way.

INT. VORIAN CARGO SHIP - BRIDGE

Bo'vic reacts to the sound of weapons fire.

BO'VIC

Commander?

Beat. More weapons blasts.

BO'VIC (CONT'D)

Commander -- what's your situation?

EXT. FOREST - DAY

Sivea is now deeper in the forest, retreating. She's returning fire, while the Kih'Andari forces advance on her. There's continuous weapons blasts throughout this scene. (We intercut as needed.)

SIVEA

(in radio)

They've found me! Am I outside the field's range?

On the bridge Bo'vic works his controls. There's a tense beat. Then...

BO'VIC

Positive. Stand by for transport.

CLOSE ON SIVEA

as she takes cover behind a large tree, firing continuous blasts with her rifle.

THE KIH'ANDARI FORCES

are covered behind some other trees, firing at Sivea. The Kih'Andari clearly have the upper hand, and we can see a few of them advancing forward, being covered by other Kih'Andari.

And then --

BACK ON SIVEA

landing some nice hits, not willing to give up. She continues firing her rifle, when...

She's encompassed by the familiar WHITE FLASH of an Asgard transporter. And as she's beamed away...

SEVERAL KIH'ANDARI arrive at her former position. It was a matter of seconds and they would have caught her.

As the Kih'Andari exchange glances...

CUT TO:

INT. KIH'ANDARI INTERROGATION ROOM - DAY

Velis is standing over a weakened Kalos. One of Velis' KIH'ANDARI ENTERS. He has a grim look on his face.

KIH'ANDARI

Our forces found who was with him.

(off Velis' look)

It was Sivea Ve'nal. But she got away... she was beamed to a ship in orbit.

Velis doesn't like what he hears. But he makes the best of it. He glances at Kalos.

VELIS

Well... at least we still have him.

Kalos looks up at Velis, knowing very well that he's at his mercy; chances of him being rescued any time soon are very slim.

Velis turns to the Kih'Andari again.

VELIS (CONT'D)

We need to evacuate this base. We can't allow the Space Command to find us here.

The Kih'Andari nods his acknowledgement. Then, Velis gives the two N.D. Guards a nod, and EXITS. The Guards then step forward, untie Kalos and hoist him to his feet.

CLOSE ON KALOS

as we push in on his bruised face, while the Guards are escorting him out of the room. Kalos is trying to make the best of his situation.

And off Kalos' expression, as he's being taken away...

CUT TO:

EXT. SPACE - HORIZON

Re-establishing the space station. The Vorian Cargo Ship has docked at one of the ramps again.

INT. BRIEFING ROOM

CLOSE ON Sivea, still wearing civilian clothing. She has a somber expression on her face.

SIVEA

By the time I made it back to the ship... the Kih'Andari had already started evacuating the base through the Stargate. They took Kalos with them.

PULL BACK to reveal that she's here with Grant, Christine, DAVID, TOM, LENORI and DANIEL. They're all standing. Grant can see that Sivea's blaming herself for Kalos' fate.

GRANT

On the bright side... they didn't find the tracker that you planted.

SIVEA

That was our one hope. At first I wanted to go back... at least capture the few Kih'Andari that were still on the base... try and get some answers from them.

DAVID

It's unlikely they would have talked.

TOM

He's right. At least now, the Space Command is able to track the location of their ship. There's a chance that'll lead us to Kalos.

Sivea considers that. It's what she's been thinking as well.

SIVEA

Let's hope so.

GRANT

You made the right call.

A moment as Sivea acknowledges Grant's words, appreciating them.

NEW ANGLE

as Callen ENTERS from his office. His features are filled with surprise, as he breaks the news.

CALLEN

I've just heard back from the Space Command, and... you won't believe what they told me.

They all look at him with anticipation.

DANIEL

Good news or bad news?

CALLEN

Apparently Kalos was able to escape the Kih'Andari's custody.

This catches them all off guard.

SIVEA

How...?

CALLEN

I haven't gotten those details yet. But he must have had help from someone. He was able to gate to a Vorian colony from where he contacted the Space Command. He's given them the rouges' last known location, and we have ships dispatched there right now.

SIVEA

What about the ship they had on the base?

CALLEN

The Kih'Andari Council was cooperative when we gave them the evidence. We were able to track it down. It seems these rouges' were led by a man named Velis; he was one of Der'ash's strongest supporters.

There's a beat as they're taking this in. They're all a little dubious about it.

LENORI

It would appear everything has come to a good ending after all.

CHRISTINE

I don't wanna sound negative, but... it does seem a little convenient.

TOM

Maybe Kalos just got lucky. Happens to us a lot.

CLOSE ON SIVEA

as she can't help but have a suspicious look in her eyes. And off her features, as she ponders this...

EXT. SPACE - HORIZON

Re-establishing the space station.

INT. SIVEA'S QUARTERS

Sivea is pacing around. She's back in her uniform, and her expression is thoughtful. She can't shake off the feeling that something's not quite right.

After a moment her door CHIMES. She has a feeling she already knows who this will be. Beat.

SIVEA

Come in.

The door slides open and Kalos ENTERS. He's still got some bruises in his face, but his wounds have been dressed. His left eye is still swollen. There's a beat as Sivea regards him -- she's not trusting him.

SIVEA (CONT'D)

I heard you were here.

Kalos nods as he steps forward. His expression is hard to read.

KALOS

I just came to thank you for your participation. Without your help, we would have never been able to take down Velis' cell.

SIVEA

(pointedly)

Well, you played quite a role yourself.

KALOS

I was lucky. And I thank the Originators for that.

But Sivea just stares at him, and we can feel a subtle tension beginning to sparkle up.

SIVEA

Was it the Originators? Or rather the fact that you've been dishonest with me this entire time?

There's a beat. But then Kalos nods slightly; he's not surprised that she's already starting to put the pieces together.

KALOS

(not denying it)

And just what do you think I've been dishonest about?

SIVEA

Why don't you tell me? And why don't you start with explaining how you were able to escape Velis' custody? Because I already have a theory.

Kalos slightly steps forward. Despite his bruised face, we can see that typical expression in his eyes again; the one where it's hard to tell whether or not we can actually trust this man.

KALOS

I'm curious... what's your theory?

SIVEA

Obviously, you've had help. But the question is... why would someone in a rogues cell decide to help you escape -- just like that?

(beat)

Unless, of course... it was somebody you had already been in contact with. Which could almost make one think... that you were planning on getting captured. And by the way... was there really a disturbance field in place that prevented Bo'vic from beaming you out? Or did he have orders to leave you behind?

Kalos stares at her in silence for a long beat.

KALOS

Your skills are impressive... and you're right. My intention was to allow myself to get captured all along. I knew they'd interrogate me, but... it was something I had to do -- a sacrifice I needed to make.

Sivea is growing angry, but she's staying calm. She doesn't like being deceived.

KALOS (CONT'D)

(sincere)

I do regret not having been able to be forthcoming with you.

SIVEA

(angry)

Why don't you spare me the speech!? -- and instead tell me what the hell is going on here!

KALOS

My incentive was to take down Velis' rouges cell. I knew about him, even talked to him on a few occasions while I was pretending to be working with the Syndicate. I knew he was a very dangerous man, just waiting for his chance to reek havoc.

KALOS (CONT'D)

(beat)

Originally I believed that his base was located in the Ven'kora system, but... obviously that information was outdated.

SIVEA

(putting the pieces together)

So... he must have known you were onto him... which is why he left one of his ships at Ven'kora.

KALOS

I knew there was a chance of that happening. And that's why I needed you to come with me. I may have not been able to be completely honest with you... but that doesn't change the fact that you've saved my life again.

SIVEA

Come to think of it -- I'm already starting to regret that.

Kalos winces a bit at hearing that. After a beat, he goes on, stays on the subject.

KALOS

I had a contact in Velis' rouges cell. It's somebody who had been wanting out for a while, ever since the attack on Vorian. He felt that the rogues had crossed the lines, he no longer supported their cause. But suffice to say, if you're a member of a rogue Kih'Andari cell, they don't just let you quit and walk away. So I made a deal with him. I'd help him get out... and in return, he'd provide me with... something of enormous value.

SIVEA

And just what is that?

Kalos holds a beat. Then he tells her:

KALOS

Enoly components for a biogenic weapon... like the one the rogues had in their possession last year.

Sivea is shocked.

SIVEA

What...?!

KALOS

Velis had been in the process of constructing another weapon.

(MORE)

KALOS (CONT'D)

As you may recall, part of the weapons' components were delivered by the Enoly. Velis still had some in his possession -- the parts that weren't used in Der'ash's weapon. It would have taken him a long time to get this new weapon operational, but his plan was to eventually finish what Der'ash started.

(beat)

A few weeks ago I came to Kohmar with the evidence... and Kohmar may be an idealist... but he saw the necessity to take action.

SIVEA

What kind of action...?

KALOS

The President entrusted me with carrying out a mission to not only take down Velis' cell... but to procure the components. We knew this had to happen under the radar, so the Vorian government could safely deny knowledge of this in the event the Kih'Andari Council would find out about it. We didn't know how they would react, if they knew that we now have all we need to build our own biogenic weapon.

SIVEA

(struggling with that thought)

The government was in on this...

KALOS

I'm the one who worked out the details. And I'm the one who decided to get you involved.

SIVEA

I can't believe that Kohmar would support the idea of Vorian using or even building a weapon of mass destruction!

KALOS

He doesn't. But there's members of his administration that feel we should... keep our options open.

(with meaning)

And let's just say... I intend to make sure that none of this was in vain. I'm sorry to tell you that the rumors about my... "retirement," have been exaggerated.

Sivea's anger is starting to get the better of her.

SIVEA

I'll see to it that that weapon never gets built -- I'll do whatever it takes! You've seen what the damn thing can do! Six million men, women and children were wiped out because of it!

KALOS

(hard)

Trust me, I haven't forgotten about that. And that's exactly why we need to ensure that Vorian is better protected than it ever was before.

SIVEA

There are other ways for us to protect Vorian!

KALOS

Other ways -- maybe. But I prefer to resort to the most effective way.

He regards her with a certain arrogance.

KALOS (CONT'D)

It's a shame... I was hoping you'd understand.

(smugly)

But now I'm realizing I may have praised you too soon.

Sivea's is now literally seething with anger. She steps even closer towards him.

SIVEA

Get out of here!

Kalos smirks, seemingly looking down at her now.

KALOS

Well, thank you for your help, nevertheless.

(then)

Who knows, maybe one of these days we can have dinner again...

(intimately)

... maybe even take things between us a step further. Trust me, that would make me a... very happy man.

Sivea reacts with disgust to his obvious suggestion of intimacy between them. But then --

SIVEA

Oh, I have a better idea...

And... BAM! She gives him a HARD PUNCH to his already bruised face, knocking him back against a wall.

Kalos winces, as he looks at her with some surprise, once again bleeding from his lip. Sivea glares at him threateningly.

SIVEA (CONT'D)
(threateningly)
Now get out of my quarters... while
you're still able to walk.

Kalos can tell that she's serious. He straightens up, and gives her a calm look. The arrogance is still there, but he's smart enough to not provoke her any further.

KALOS
Until next time, Commander.

And with that, he EXITS.

CLOSE ON SIVEA

as she stares at the spot where he just stood. We slowly push in on her as she's filled with enormous anger for this man. And she knows that ultimately their paths will cross again.

Hold on her reaction for a beat, and then...

FADE OUT.

END OF ACT FIVE

THE END

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And now, make sure to head on over to the GateWorld Episode thread to share your thoughts on tonight's episode!
