and our Poppa I guess we are a pretty big organization after all!!!! **Please pray specifically for insight and wisdom as well as courage for us and our District Commissioner Mr. Simwaka our District Social Services Officer Mr. Mzondola** as well as understanding for a lady named Lois and others from (unnamed) organization, as well as a Social Services officer named Helen ... The pictures you see are of one of our boys Sino. He is 9 years old and battling the worst ...his immune system has been losing ground . We were advised just last week (while in Blantyre) by specialists dealing with this Virus, to upgrade his treatment to a last ditch program administered by a well –funded Italian NGO who I believe have one of the best facilities in Malawi. This was after reviewing his CD4 count (100), his history and examination. They accepted him and we now have him under their treatment . While we hope for years of life, we do not know how long he will be able to hold out and we sincerely ask for your prayer and insights from Holy Spirit. The issue is a group (they have considerable influence due to funds poured in re abnormal adopting issues here in Malawi) has been pressuring Social Services to move Sino to a Blantyre Children's home. In normal circumstances we would likely have no problem with this., we need the space. In fact just a few months ago we released two little ones to that home (called SOS) . SOS has a good system and much funding. By the way, Sino was brought to us a year ago, due to him having relational problems at another home he was in near Blantyre. We were surprised while in Blantyre with Sino, to receive a call from a lady from Soc. Serv. stating they would be coming to pick up Sino and by what right do we take him to Blantyre ...very sad ... no consultation, no concern for preparation of any kind to ascertain Sino's condition physical, emotional or anything..."just get him ready!!" Fortunately we had him in Blantyre with us while we were doing some new baby house things and along with him, five friends to keep him company (this was the express reason for taking the 5 other little boys., trying to build good memories and experiences for him) We now wait for a meeting hopefully next week ?? with Mr. Simwaka and Mr. Mzondola. Plse pray for Sino.
