

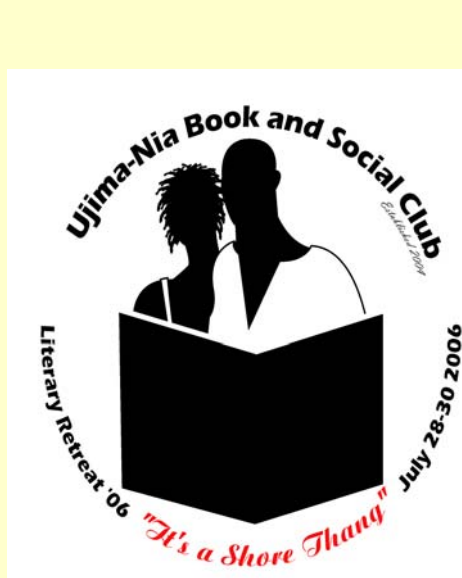


Ujima-Nia
