- Championship events – selected from the winners of classes eligible
- Reserve Champion – selected from the remaining winners & second placegetter in the class which provided the Champion.
- Entry Fees :
 - Show Driving / Cone Driving \$ 10.00 per class or \$ 60.00 unlimited (Covers all Saturday/Sunday program **excluding** dressage))
 - Official Dressage \$15.00 per class (maximum of 2 tests per horse)
- No horse yards – tie ups stalls available – can make your own overnight yards. Bring yards to secure your horse overnight.
- Camping permitted – hot showers and toilets, tea & coffee facilities in the office.

Vehicles of Traditional two or four wheel design with wooden or steel wheels.
