Who doesn't like a Whoopie Pie?

Cookies:

1 cup sugar	2 cups flour
2 egg yolks	4 Tbsp cocoa
½ cup shortening	1 tsp baking powder
1 cup milk	½ tsp baking soda
1 tsp vanilla	½ tsp salt

Combine first five (5) ingredients and beat well, about five (5) minutes. Sift dry ingredients and add to the mixture. Drop on cookie sheet and bake @ 350° for ten (10) minutes or until done.

Filling:

2 egg whites
2 cups confectionary sugar
2/3 cup Crisco
1 tsp vanilla

tsp = teaspoon; Tbsp = tablespoon

Beat egg whites until stiff, set aside. Beat confectionary sugar and Crisco until creamy. Add vanilla and egg whites that have been beaten stiff. Mix well until very creamy. Spread filling between cookies.

Place in your cooler, and take out on the trail. Everyone will enjoy one
