Can I go 4-wheeling now? No, not unless you are riding on your own property. Acadia Area ATV'ers trails, as well as most trails, are closed for mud season. Once they open up for riding, our web page will tell you.

When does my 4-wheeler registration expire? You can ride your 4-wheeler until the end of June each year. Registrations expire June 30th.

Do I need insurance on my 4-wheeler? Most of us, for our own protection and yours, have opted to have insurance. It is reasonable and if you need it – you'd be glad you have it.

What do I need to ride on Cherryfield Foods land? In order to ride on Cherryfield Foods property they would like you to belong to an ATV club and in doing so you would get a CFI pass that you should keep with your 4-wheeler in case you are asked to show it.
