Gone, but not forgotten.

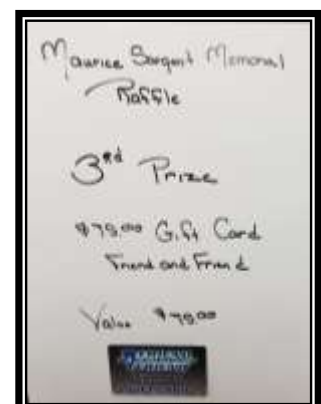
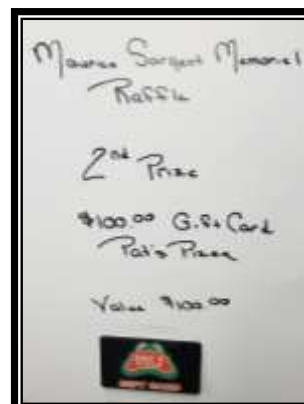
