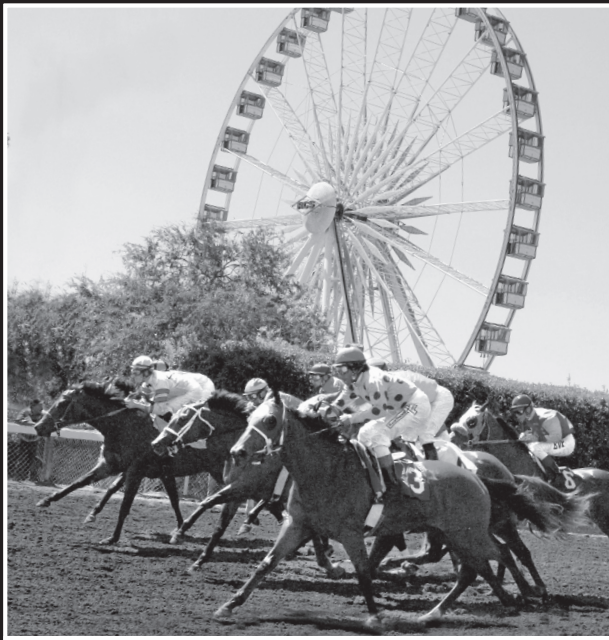




Fairplex Park

Racing at the fair is fun for fans and horse racing insiders alike. HRTV host Peter Lurie says, **"I've been a huge fan of Fairplex since I was a small child. I think the first time I was at Fairplex I must have been about ten. There's something about it that I absolutely love."** Lurie is set to be Fairplex's in-house television commentator for the 2008 meet. Lurie recounts the 2007 Pomona Derby as his favorite Fairplex memory, won by *Frank The Barber*, a horse he co-owns.

Joanne Jones, also an HRTV host and anchor of Fairplex's paddock show for the past five years, is very fond of the track where she got her start in horse racing alongside her father, handicapper and writer Prof. Gordon Jones. **"I just enjoy the whole atmosphere out there. It's very, very different... Everybody seems to be in a good mood, having fun. It's just a great way for people to try to learn the game, learn about racing, and meet people, since everybody is very accessible at Fairplex."**
