INFORMATION re PROPOSED VHF WEATHER NET

STARTUP DATE & TIME: Monday, Jan.03, 1994. 07:45 ASt  
This time suggested to allow call-in by Amateurs enroute to work.  
Also, the Wx. Office wishes reports in by 08:30 hrs.  
NET FREQUENCIES: 146.76 Mhz. (PD) & 146.70 Mhz. (BI) Repeaters.  
Efforts are under way to link the two repeaters so that we  
can get better coverage into Charlotte Co. This will call  
for 2 Net Controls at startup until we find out if the  
tie-in will work satisfactorily.  
Mona, VE9MR, will act as PD Net Control for startup and relay  
information to Wx. Office after Net closes.  
NET OPERATION: Monday to Friday, wx. forecasts predict severe  
conditions over the week-end. Under those conditions the Net  
operations will be extended.  
LOCATION IDENTIFICATION: Operators on the WINTER WX. NET should  
identify their actual location, (ie. "LOON BAY",etc.) This will  
differ from the Severe Weather "CANWARN" where the ZONE or GRID  
Sq. will probably be used.  
HERE FOLLOWS LIST OF CODES for reporting Wx. Conditions:

SKY: (cloud cover- in /10ths.  
WX:  
Drizzle. Showers. Rain. Freez. Rain Snow. Ice Pellets. T.Storms.  
Light: L- RW- R- ZR- S- IP- TRW-  
Moderate L RW R ZR S IP TRW  
Heavy L+ RW+ R+ ZR+ S+ IP+ TRW+  
A Mixture of Above: (report as such)  
FOG: F-, F, Ft.  
VISIBILITY: (In MILES, up to 6).  
WIND DIRECTION: (8 points of the Compass, N, NE, E, SE, S, SW, W, NW.  
" SPEED (knots). (possibly better in MPH, but specify.)  
PRECIPITATION: 24 hr. if so equipped.  
TEMPERATURE: 24 hr. " " "  
ROAD REPORT: We suggest this, if conditions help normal.  
Wx Office does not require. They claim DOT responsible!!!
