JESSICA, 19, with long blond hair, wears a red dress that drops off the shoulders.

She glides into the room.

JESSICA

Sorry I'm late.

She twirls on the spot.

JESSICA

You like?

She finishes with a curtsy.

HENRY

You're beautiful.

She sits down opposite.

JESSICA

Thanks.

HENRY

But of course you knew I'd say that.

Henry gets down on one knee.

HENRY

And here's one you didn't expect me to say.

Jessica gasps.

HENRY

Will you marry me?

Jessica nods.

JESSICA

Yes, yes I'd love to marry you.

Henry moves in to kiss Jessica.

INT. BRIDAL SHOP - DAY

THREE MONTHS LATER

JESSICA, 19, with short black hair, tries on a dress.

JESSICA

What do you think? Good, bad?

Henry takes a moment to judge her dress of choice.

HENRY

Hmmm...You're putting on a little weight.

Jessica frowns and stomps towards the changing rooms.

INT. CHURCH - DAY

THREE MONTHS LATER

Henry waits with the PRIEST as his bride slowly walks down the aisle.

Henry puffs out his cheeks and raises his eyebrows to the Priest.

HENRY (V.O.)

I can't believe how much weight she's put on.

INT. LIVING ROOM - DAY

TWO MONTHS LATER

Jessica puts the phone down and begins to cry. Henry puts his arm around her.

HENRY

What's the matter?

JESSICA

My...my...mother's died.

HENRY (V.O.)

Thank fuck for that.

INT. WAKE - EVENING

ONE WEEK LATER

Jessica and Henry stand next to the open casket of her MOTHER.

The Priest stands on the other side of Jessica.

PRIEST

I'm sorry for your loss Jessica. Sally will be greatly missed.

JESSICA

Thank you father.

Henry looks away.

HENRY (V.O.)

Don't say it.

PRIEST

I'm here for you. You're not alone.

HENRY (V.O.)

I have to, I must.

PRIEST

Your mother's a great loss to the community.

JESSICA

Thank you.

Henry shouts out suddenly.

HENRY

I'm glad the bitch is dead.

He covers his mouth in shock.

Jessica runs out of the room crying.

EXT. DRIVE - MORNING

ONE WEEK LATER

Jessica throws a luggage bag into the back of her car.

Henry chases after her in his open dressing gown.

HENRY

Where are you going Jessica? I haven't seen you in a week.

Jessica slams the door down.

JESSICA

What does it look like? I'm leaving you!

Jessica opens the driver's door.

HENRY

I'm sorry! How many times have I tried to explain myself?

INT./EXT. CAR

Jessica carefully enters the car and opens the window.

JESSICA

And I've just discovered yesterday...I'm pregnant.

EXT. DRIVE

Henry puts his hands to his head and his mouth agape.

HENRY (V.O.)

Shit.
