Women whose efforts have often been ignored in telling the story of America. This Project will focus on The Women's Suffrage Movement



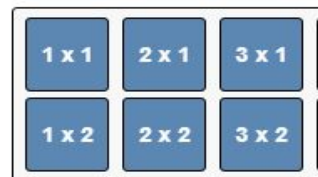
Why are we doing this?
