Willard Carroll Smith Jr. was born in Philadelphia, PA. His mother is a former school board administrator and his father was a refrigeration engineer. He attended Overbrook High School, and was admitted to a pre-engineering summer program at MIT. However, he had no intention of going to college as he already wanted to go have a musical career as a rapper. With his childhood friend Jeffrey Townes, they became DJ Jazzy Jeff & The Fresh Prince. They won the first Grammy award in the Rap category. In 1990, he appeared in a TV series built around his character. The Fresh Prince of Bel-Air was a successful NBC show that ran for 6 seasons. It launched his acting career. He appeared in blockbuster movies one after the other. He held several movie records, such as the actor to have 8 consecutive films to gross over \$100 million, 5 of which taking over \$500 million. He had 11 consecutive films that gross over \$150 million. As of 2014, his films has gross over \$6.6B. Fortune Magazine listed him many times among the Richest 40 Americans under the age 40.
