**PLEASE NOTE: This show is open TO ALL PHAA Reg. horses. All riders, owners, exhibitors, handlers and youths must be current financial members of the PHAA to show, ride or exhibit in approved events at the State Championships. All horses entered must be registered with the PHAA. Pending registrations ARE NOT accepted. Registration numbers and membership numbers must be listed on entry form.**

All Amateur Owners & Youth MUST hold a current Amateur Owner or Youth card with the PHAA. A photocopy of your AO, Masters AO, or Youth membership card must accompany all entries and must also be available for inspection on the day. Amateurs and Youth competing on two or more horses must nominate which horses are to count for high point nominations.

All competitors who are not PPHAT Inc members who are handling or riding a horse entered in this show are required to pay a temporary Day Membership fee of \$15 for insurance purposes.

NUMBERS Must be worn by all competitors and will be provided and must be returned

Marshalling Area: This is for competitors and Show Officials only. No spectators allowed. There is no alcohol to be taken into or consumed in the Marshalling area and/or show arena. Competitors are responsible for their attendance in the marshalling area in a timely manner, if you are not on time the gates will be closed.

Competitor's/participants at any event run by the Performance Paint Horse Association of Tasmania Inc have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the the PHAA at all times. Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for

your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.

All youth competing or taking part in an PHAA approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contestant, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an PHAA approved events, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.

At all PHAA approved shows, on each day of the show, 1 hour prior to the commencement of the show and 1 hour after the cessation of the show, there will be no training equipment allowed in the immediate marshalling area and the performance arena and dress regulations of Cap/Hat, long western style pants, safe enclosed footwear and a shirt with sleeves must be worn.

Exhibitors shall not approach the judge for any reason prior to completion of the judging, unless the exhibitor has finished exhibiting and the request must be made through the Ring Steward. No exhibitor will request information from the Judge, or the decisions made by that Judge, concerning any exhibit at a show, on the day of the show or within the immediate 7 days following the show.

Refunds: Any request for a refund is to be accompanied by a Vet Certificate stating the reason the animal is unfit for competition. Any request for a refund from a rider/handler is to be accompanied by a Medical Certificate from a Doctor stating the reason the competitor is unfit for competition. These certificates must be produced 48 hours prior to commencement of the show. Upon receipt of such certificate/s will result in the entry being scratched and a refund of all monies paid to date less \$20.00 Office/Facility fee to be retained by PPHAT.

Trail: No unauthorised entry allowed into the trail area once obstacles are positioned before or during the show.

Any exhibitor who refuses to obey the request of the show manager, may be barred from further competition after consultation with the show committee and forfeit all previous winnings together with entry fee and other charges. At the discretion of the show manager, in consultation with the show committee, the offending individual and his/her entire exhibit may be removed from the grounds.

#### **FACILITY RULES:**

No dogs will be allowed whatsoever – not even in a car. This is not negotiable.

All manure from yards and camping area must be put in bags and placed in designated area as instructed by show management.

No horse yards to be built in camping area.

No lunging horses in the arena.

All Camping to be behind the bank and all horses tied to floats to be kept away from power outlets and leads. All power leads MUST be covered by a rubber mat or similar. Areas designated as "Horse Only" are ONLY to be accessed by horses and handlers named on entry form, STRICTLY no spectators in these areas. You are required to comply with any reasonable direction from show staff in relation to safety.

Any fees owing before commencement of show, will prevent that person from entering the Show Arena

– this rule will be strictly enforced. **(This includes Office/Facility fees).**

**NO LIABILITY ACCEPTED** for loss of or damage to animals, persons or property.

**ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND WILL BE DEEMED ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES.**

ALL COMPETITORS COMPETE AT THEIR OWN RISK AND NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE TAKEN FOR ACCIDENT, DAMAGE OR INJURY TO HORSES, RIDERS OR SPECTATORS AND PROPERTY WHILST ON THE GROUNDS.

**A note from the PPHAT Inc Committee;**

It is expected that all competitors will be familiar with the class requirements re; their attire and tack for each respective class. It is not expected that competitors go to the extreme expense to present themselves and their horses, but there are specific requirements for tack and attire stipulated in the rules. This is a STATE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW, and as such, is a showcase of our breed and all rules will be adhered to and enforced.

The PPHAT Inc Committee asks that competitors make themselves familiar with tack and attire requirements. It is a mark of respect for the Judge, to fellow competitors, your horse and yourself to have presented yourself appropriately, in a clean and tidy fashion and to the best of their ability.

**Classics will need 3 entrants in each event to go ahead**

Classic payments for each individual event are paid out as follows;

Classic prize money will be paid by cheque after the show. Cheques will be mailed to competitors.

**Yearling Versatility**

**Yearling Versatility will need 3 entrants to go ahead.**

The yearling versatility is open to versatility nominated horses and can be either Regular Registry or Paint Bred Solid horses.

The following events form the Yearling Versatility;

- Yearling Versatility Halter
- Yearling Versatility Lungeline
- Yearling Versatility Hunter In Hand
- Yearling Versatility Led Trail

These events are exclusively for the Yearling Versatility entrants. To be considered for this award all entrants must compete in all four legs and pay the \$25.00 nomination fee. Points are calculated as per HSAA High Point calculations outlined below. The committee reserves the right to change the order of classes on the day.

### **High Point Awards**

High Point calculations will be based on HSAA rules, e.g. 6 horses – 1<sup>st</sup> = 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place = 5 horses, etc to 6<sup>th</sup> place = 1 point

High Point awards will be awarded to the following categories, and in the following events;

Youth – 41, 59 or 63, 66, 72, 81, 91, 98, 105, 111

Amateur – 42, 53, 60 or 64, 67, 75, 84, 94, 101, 108, 112

Masters Amateur Owner – 43, 54, 61 or 65, 68, 76, 85, 95, 102, 109, 113

2 year old Performance Horse – 50, 71, 80, 90.

Junior Performance Horse – 51, 73, 82, 92, 99, 106

Senior Performance Horse – 52, 74, 83, 93, 100, 107

In the event of a tie break, the horse with the most first place ribbons shall be determined the winner. The judge will have the final decision if the tie cannot be broken.

High Point Amateur and High Point Youth Awards at PHAA approved shows must be based on a one horse/one rider basis. The contestant to be eligible must show in at least three (3) classes over two (2) categories.

### **DRUG TESTING**

This show may be subject to mandatory drug swabbing.

All horses competing in PHAA approved shows are subject to a 'No Prohibited Substance Rule'. This means that no horse may be administered a prohibited substance before an event that might have any effect on its performance. The owner/handler/exhibitor must present the horse for collection of blood, saliva and/or urine samples upon request. The owner/handler/exhibitor is held responsible and accountable for this condition of the horse and for compliance with this policy, and shall comply with any request made by the PHAA in relation to this policy.

For advice on prohibited substances please refer to your Veterinarian or the Australian Racing Forensic Laboratory. In the event of a positive test to a prohibited substance the PHAA may take disciplinary action in accordance with the rules
