

WATERPARK RULES



For the safety and comfort of all are guests, please...

- **NO OUTSIDE FOOD & BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED IN THE WATERPARK**
- No person under 16 years of age is allowed in the hot tub.
- Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult or guardian of 18 years of age or older.
- All slides require children to be 42" tall. Children under 42" can use the slides in Buddy's Play Land. Height restriction and rules of behavior are posted at each activity for your safety.
- No running, jumping, horseplay, or diving in the water park.
- Take a cleansing shower before entering the pool.
- No floating device, snorkels, toys, or scuba fins supplied by guests are allowed in the water park except for USCG approved devices.
- Proper swimming attire is required. No cut-off shorts or wet suits are permitted.
- **All guests are expected to follow all lifeguard and water park staff instructions.**
- Goggles and nose plugs are allowed everywhere in the park except on the water slides.
- Eyewear must be securely affixed to riders with head straps when riding the slides.
- Approved swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained. These diapers can be purchased at the front desk.
- No diaper changing is allowed on the deck, tables, or lounge chairs. Please use the diaper changing station in the locker room.
- The water is for everyone to enjoy. Please refrain from drinking, spitting, spouting, or blowing of nose in the pool. Offensive behavior such as shouting or use of profanity is prohibited.
- Management reserves the right to
 - Administer any additional rules or regulations without prior notice
 - Take photography and videos for promotional purposes
 - Limit admissions at any time
- You will be refused admission and/or asked to leave if
 - Your behavior affects the safety and comfort of others.
 - You are suspected of being under the influences of drugs or intoxication.
 - You have excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, or bandages.
 - You show evidence of skin disease, sore, or inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharge, infectious conditions or communicable diseases.

Life jackets are recommended for younger children and are available from our lifeguards.
